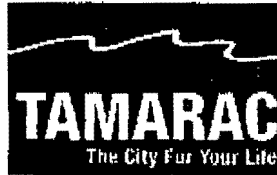

Dear Sheriff Lamberti: *pl*

Under the previous Agreement for Police Services between the City of Tamarac and the Broward Sheriff's Office, Law Enforcement Trust Fund, monies designated for the City of Tamarac were held in an account by the BSO Bureau of Finance and Budget in an account designated as, Law Enforcement Trust Fund – City of Tamarac (68420).

Under the current Agreement for Police Services, which was executed 6-22-05, Article 12 states, "... subsequently forfeited to the Tamarac District, shall be deposited into the CITY'S Law Enforcement Trust Fund established by the CITY..."

Since the adoption of the current Agreement for Police Services all new forfeited funds have been turned over to the City of Tamarac Finance Department for deposit in the City held L.E.T.F. account.

I would like to request that the balance of the funds remaining in the account being held by the Broward Sheriff's Office Bureau of Finance and Budget be forwarded to the City of Tamarac Finance Department for deposit in the City held account. It is my understanding that as of the date of the last statement, 9-16-09, the balance on that account was \$176,584.89.
