1 AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY
 2 COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA,
 3 PERTAINING TO THE HISTORICAL COMMISSION;
 4 AMENDING CHAPTER 1, ARTICLE VII, SECTION 1-117,
 5 OF THE BROWARD COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES,
 6 RELATING TO CONTRACTUAL SERVICES; PROVIDING
 7 FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN
 8 THE CODE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

10 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida,
 11 desires to amend the Historical Commission Ordinance to specify that it may contract
 12 with individuals, corporations, or other legal entities for the services of a County
 13 historian and/or archaeologist.

14 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
 15 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

16 Section 1. Section 1-117 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances is hereby
 17 amended to read as follows:

18 **Sec. 1-117. Membership, officers, employees, qualifications, and method of
 19 appointment.**

21 (b) The Historical Commission may, when necessary, recommend to the
 22 Board of County Commissioners contracting for services such as, but not limited to, a
 23 "county historian" and a "county archaeologist," through agreements with individuals,
 24 corporations, or other legal entities, each subject to the approval of the Board of County
 Commissioners.

Section 3. SEVERABILITY.

If any portion of this Ordinance is determined by any Court to be invalid, the invalid portion shall be stricken, and such striking shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance. If any Court determines that this Ordinance, or any portion hereof, cannot be legally applied to any individual(s), group(s), entity(ies), property(ies), or circumstance(s), such determination shall not affect the applicability hereof to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

Section 4. INCLUSION IN CODE.

It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Broward County Code; and that the sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or re-lettered and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section," "article," or such other appropriate word or phrase in order to accomplish such intentions.

Section 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance shall become effective as provided by law.
