

RESOLUTION NO. 2009-

1 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
2 BROWARD COUNTY TRANSMITTING A PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO
3 THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL COORDINATION ELEMENT OF THE
4 BROWARD COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN TO THE DEPARTMENT
OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

5 WHEREAS, Broward County adopted the 1989 Broward County Comprehensive
6 Plan on March 1, 1989 (the Plan); and

7 WHEREAS, the Department of Community Affairs has found the Broward County
8 Comprehensive Plan in compliance with the Local Government Comprehensive
9 Planning and Land Development Regulation Act; and

10 WHEREAS, Broward County now wishes to propose an amendment to the
11 Intergovernmental Coordination Element, Broward County Comprehensive Plan; and

12 WHEREAS, the Environmental Protection and Growth Management Department,
13 as the local planning agency for the Broward County Comprehensive Plan, held its
14 hearing on the proposed amendment to the Intergovernmental Coordination Element,
15 Broward County Comprehensive Plan, on February 6, 2009, with due public notice; and

16 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners held its transmittal public
17 hearing on March 24, 2009, at 2:00 p.m., having complied with the notice requirements
18 specified in Section 163.3184(15), Florida Statutes, as amended from time to time; and

19 WHEREAS, the proposed amendment constitutes a portion of Broward County's
20 permitted first annual amendments to the Plan for 2009; NOW, THEREFORE,

21 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
22 BROWARD COUNTY:

23 Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners hereby transmits to the
24 Department of Community Affairs for review and comment pursuant to Section

1 163.3184, Florida Statutes, as amended from time to time, Amendment 09-1-T3, which
2 is an amendment to the Intergovernmental Coordination Element.

3 Section 2. The proposed amendment to the Broward County Comprehensive
4 Plan is attached as Attachment "A" to this Resolution.

5 Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.

6 This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.

PROPOSED INTERGOVERNMENTAL COORDINATION ELEMENT REVISIONS

Policy 15.1.1. Broward County shall:

1. Use the Broward County Comprehensive Planning Council workshops which are scheduled six times during the year bimonthly, to coordinate planning activities mandated by the various elements of the Comprehensive Plan with local governments, the School Board of Broward County, other governmental units providing services but not having regulatory authority over the use of land, the region, and the state.

Policy 15.1.3. ~~The Department of Safety and Emergency Services Permitting, Licensing and Consumer Protection Division~~ shall continue to provide, where financially feasible, building and permitting services to municipalities through interlocal agreements.

Objective 15.2. Utilize coordinating mechanisms to ensure that the potential development impacts allowed by the Broward County Comprehensive Plan upon development in adjacent local governments, the School Board of Broward County, the Region, and the State are addressed. ~~3(b)(2)~~

Policy 15.2.1. ~~Urban Planning and Redevelopment Department (URPD)~~ ~~Environmental Protection and Growth Management Department (EPGMD)~~ shall ensure the potential development impacts allowed by the Broward County Comprehensive Plan on adjacent jurisdictions are addressed through the following mechanisms, processes or procedures:

Policy 15.2.6. Broward County shall collaborate with local, regional and state agencies and governments to create and implement Transit / Housing Oriented Redevelopment (THOR) corridor plans.

Objective 15.3. Ensure the coordinated establishment of level of service standards for public facilities with agencies and/or municipalities having operational and maintenance responsibilities for such facilities.

Policy 15.3.1. Broward County shall ensure the coordinated establishment of level of service standards as follows:

1. For transportation facilities, the level of service standard shall be coordinated through the Transportation Planning Division, which serves as staff to the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization.

3. For solid waste facilities, the level of service standard shall be coordinated through the Waste and Recycling Services Pollution Prevention and Remediation Division.

~~**Policy 15.3.2.** Broward County shall ensure the coordinated establishment of level of service standards as follows:~~

- ~~41. For potable water facilities, the level of service standard shall be coordinated through the Water and Wastewater Services Division.~~

- ~~2. For solid waste facilities, the level of service standard shall be coordinated through the Waste and Recycling Services Division.~~

Policy 15.3.2. Broward County will coordinate with municipalities supplying water to unincorporated areas and those municipalities which receive water from WWSD. This coordination will include sharing and updating information regarding the 10 Year Water Supply Plan to meet ongoing water supply needs and the implementation of alternate water supplies.

Policy 15.3.3. The Department of Community Services Department shall:

2. Assure that when a local park is annexed or incorporated into a municipality, that the local parks level of service standard will not be violated. The local parks level of service standard shall be assured either by Recreation and Open Space Element Policy 9.3.2. ~~5.~~ or through the execution of an interlocal agreement providing that the County retains credit for the local park under its concurrency management system.

~~**Policy 15.4.3.** All codes and ordinances referenced in this Element are as adopted as of October 1, 1998.~~
