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2 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY  
3 COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA  
4 AMENDING THE BROWARD COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE  
5 CODE, VOLUME II, CHAPTER 42.A AND INCORPORATED  
6 IN SECTION 42.25 OF THE BROWARD COUNTY  
7 ADMINISTRATIVE CODE; PROVIDING FOR INCREASES  
8 IN DOCKAGE, WHARFAGE, CONTAINER CRANE RENTAL,  
9 AND GENERAL PORT SERVICES; PROVIDING RULES  
10 AND REGULATIONS TEXT UPDATES TO SECTIONS 1, 2,  
11 4, 7, 10 AND 11; PROVIDING TWO ADDITIONAL NEW  
12 ITEMS: IN SECTION 5 PROVIDING FOR INCENTIVES FOR  
13 NEW CONTAINER CARRIER SERVICES; AND SECTION  
14 10 PROVIDING FOR PETROLEUM AND LIQUEFIED  
15 PETROLEUM GAS TERMINAL FACILITIES; PROVIDING  
16 FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE  
17 BROWARD COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE;  
18 PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

12 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County desires to  
13 amend the Broward County Administrative Code, Volume II, Chapter 42.A, Port  
14 Everglades Tariff No. 12; and

15 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that the revisions to the  
16 Port Everglades Tariff No. 12 as set forth herein, are necessary and in the best interests  
17 of Broward County; NOW, THEREFORE,

18 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF  
19 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

20 Section 1. Port Everglades Tariff No. 12, codified as Exhibit 42.A and  
21 incorporated in Section 42.25 of the Broward County Administrative Code, is hereby  
22 amended as attached.

1 Section 2. SEVERABILITY.

2 If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any Court to be invalid, the  
3 invalid portion shall be stricken, and such striking shall not affect the validity of the  
4 remainder of this Resolution. If any Court determines that this Resolution, or any  
5 portion hereof, cannot be legally applied to any individual(s), group(s), entity(ies),  
6 property(ies), or circumstance(s), such determination shall not affect the applicability  
7 hereof to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

8 Section 3. INCLUSION IN THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE.

9 It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of  
10 this Resolution shall become and be made a part of the Broward County Administrative  
11 Code; and that the sections of this Resolution be renumbered or re-lettered and the  
12 word "resolution" may be changed to "section," "article," or such other appropriate word  
13 or phrase in order to accomplish such intentions.

14 Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

15 This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
