At the discretion of the Board, presentations to the Board of County Commissioners by the ranked firms may be r equired. Information and documents reviewed by E valuation Committee members as part of the evaluation process are posted for general review on the Purchasing Division website located <u>at the RFP/RLI Supporting Documents Repository.</u>

The estimated time the final Agreement will come to the Board for approval and execution within 45 days from the final approval of the ranking.
