

1 **RESOLUTION NO. 2014-**2 OF THE RESOLUTION **BOARD** OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY. FLORIDA. 3 PERTAINING TO THE DIVERSITY ADVISORY COUNCIL AMENDING SECTION 12.91 OF THE BROWARD COUNTY 4 ADMINISTRATIVE CODE TO MODIFY THE NUMBER OF MEMBERS OF THE DIVERSITY ADVISORY COUNCIL; 5 AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE BROWARD COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, AND 6 AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 7 8 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida, has determined that amending Section 12.91 of the Administrative Code, decreasing the number of members of the Broward County Diversity Advisory Council, is 10 11 appropriate at this time, NOW, THEREFORE. 12 13 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF **BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:** 14 15 16 Section 1. Chapter 12, Part VIII, of the Broward County Administrative Code is 17 hereby amended as follows: 18 PART VIII. BROWARD COUNTY DIVERSITY ADVISORY COUNCIL 19 . . . 12.91. Appointments, Membership, and Organization. 20 21 a. The Broward County Diversity Advisory Council shall consist of eighteen 22 <u>nine</u> (18 9) members. Each member of the Broward Board of County Commissioners 23 shall appoint two one (2 1) members whose term of office shall be as set forth in

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- b. The Human Services Department shall provide all reasonable administrative and clerical assistance desired by the Broward County Diversity Advisory Council.
- c. The Broward County Diversity Advisory Council shall adopt rules, bylaws, or such other regulations as it deems desirable for the efficient conduct and discharge of its duties and functions.

Section 2. <u>CONFORMING OF RESOLUTIONS.</u>

All resolutions or parts of resolutions that are inconsistent or in conflict with this Resolution are hereby deemed to be conformed to this Resolution, to the extent necessary to resolve the inconsistency or conflict.

Section 3. <u>SEVERABILITY</u>.

If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any Court to be invalid, the invalid portion shall be stricken, and such striking shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Resolution. If any Court determines that this Resolution, or any portion hereof, cannot be legally applied to any individual(s), group(s), entity(ies), property(ies), or circumstance(s), such determination shall not affect the applicability hereof to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

Section 4. INCLUSION IN THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE.

It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of this Resolution shall become and be made a part of the Broward County Administrative Code; and that the sections of this Resolution be renumbered or relettered and the word
