

RESOLUTION NO. 2014-

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, APPROVING A HOMELESS PREVENTION GRANT (GRANT) FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF CHILDREN AND FAMILIES (DCF) IN THE AMOUNT OF SIXTY THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED THREE DOLLARS (\$60,903.00) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2014; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE THE GRANT AGREEMENT WITH DCF AND AMENDMENTS TO SAID AGREEMENT RELATING TO TIME EXTENSIONS; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO TAKE ANY NECESSARY ADMINISTRATIVE AND BUDGETARY ACTIONS, AND TO IMPLEMENT PROJECT CHANGES THAT DO NOT INCREASE THE TOTAL AWARD AMOUNT; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Children and Families ("DCF") has awarded a Homeless Prevention Grant to Broward County for the purpose of funding homeless prevention assistance; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida ("Board"), desires to accept the grant award and implement the homeless prevention assistance project with the money awarded by DCF; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds programs benefiting the homeless to serve a public purpose, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section1. The Board hereby authorizes appropriation of DCF Homeless Prevention grant funds for Fiscal Year 2014 in the amount of Sixty Thousand Nine

1 Hundred Three Dollars (\$60,903.00) for the purpose of funding a homeless prevention
2 assistance project to be administered and operated by the Broward County Human
3 Services Department.

4 Section 2. The County Administrator is hereby authorized to execute the
5 appropriate Homeless Prevention grant agreement with DCF and amendments thereto
6 relating to time extensions, to implement project changes that do not increase the total
7 grant amount, subject to approval by the Office of the County Attorney, and to execute
8 any necessary related administrative and budgetary actions.

9 Section 3. SEVERABILITY. If any portion of this Resolution is determined by
10 any Court to be invalid, the invalid portion shall be stricken, and such striking shall not
11 affect the validity of the remainder of this Resolution. If any Court determines that this
12 Resolution, or any portion hereof, cannot be legally applied to an individual(s), group(s),
13 entity(ies), property(ies), or circumstance(s), such determination shall not affect the
14 applicability hereof to any other individual, group, entity, property or circumstance.

15 Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

16 This Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.
