WHEREAS, the corporation referred to as Project Cardinal for the purpose of this Resolution, has requested that Broward County maintain the confidentiality of its name and business information pursuant to Section 288.075, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, Project Cardinal, currently located in the City of Sunrise, Florida, is considering expansion of its operations in the City of Sunrise, Florida; and

WHEREAS, Project Cardinal has applied for a Direct Cash/Job Creation Incentive Grant from Broward County, Florida, pursuant to Section 9½-52 of the Code of Ordinances of Broward County, Florida ("Code"), NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida (the "Board"), hereby recommends and approves a Direct Cash/Job Creation Incentive Grant for a three-year appropriation of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) for fiscal years 2015 through 2018, through Broward County's Direct Cash/Job Creation Incentive Program.

Section 2. In furtherance of the request of Project Cardinal, the Board has determined that the basis of this proposed project's private sector wage commitment calculation shall be one hundred and fifteen percent (115%) of the Broward County average annual wage.

Section 3. The amounts authorized herein shall constitute the County's total commitment to this project for participation in the Direct Cash/Job Creation Incentive Program.

Section 4. SEVERABILITY.

If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any Court to be invalid, the invalid portion shall be stricken, and such striking shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Resolution.
