DBE Compliance Comments:

Atkins North America, Inc., Michael Baker Jr., Inc., Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc., Marks Brothers, Inc., T.Y. Lin International, Inc., and EAC Consulting, Inc. are deemed compliant to the DBE requirements for this solicitation.

OESBD's original review found that EAC Consulting was non-compliant with the DBE requirements established for the RFP, based on a narrow interpretation from the using agency of the project's scope of services. However, the original solicitation document suggests that the "selected consultant team will provide the services of airport planners, civil, electrical, mechanical and geotechnical engineers and other professionals as needed to complete the work" (emphasis added). OESBD's present review of the vendor's original submission, taking into account the scope of services in its entirety, suggests that the original EAC Consulting response was consistent with the solicitation language. OESBD has therefore amended its original review to include EAC Consulting, Inc. as having met the DBE requirement as outlined in the solicitation.
