

RESOLUTION NO. 2014-

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING A DONATION FROM THE FRIENDS OF NORTH REGIONAL/BC LIBRARY, INC., IN THE AMOUNT OF THREE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$3,400), TO BE DEPOSITED IN THE BROWARD COUNTY LIBRARY TRUST FUND, TO PURCHASE LAPTOP COMPUTERS FOR PUBLIC USE AT THE BROWARD COUNTY NORTH REGIONAL/BROWARD COLLEGE LIBRARY; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO TAKE ALL ADMINISTRATIVE AND BUDGETARY ACTIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Friends of the North Regional/BC Library, Inc., has most generously offered to donate to the County Three Thousand Four Hundred Dollars (\$3,400) for the purchase of laptop computers for public use at the Broward County North Regional/Broward College Library; and

WHEREAS, Section 18.63 of the Broward County Administrative Code provides for the acceptance and acknowledgement by the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida ("Board"), of donations to the County that are valued at Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) or more; and

WHEREAS, the Board wishes to accept the generous gift and to express its gratitude for such donation, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Board hereby accepts the donation of Three Thousand Four Hundred Dollars (\$3,400) from Friends of the North Regional/BC Library, Inc., whose local address is 1100 Coconut Creek Boulevard, Coconut Creek, Florida 33066, for the purchase of laptop computers for public use at the Broward County North Regional/Broward College Library.

Section 2. The County Administrator is hereby authorized to take all administrative and budgetary actions and execute all forms required to implement acceptance of the donation in this matter.

Section 3. SEVERABILITY.

If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any Court to be invalid, the invalid portion shall be stricken, and such striking shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Resolution. If any Court determines that this Resolution, or any portion hereof, cannot be legally applied to any individual(s), group(s), entity(ies), property(ies), or circumstance(s), such determination shall not affect the applicability hereof to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
