

RESOLUTION NO. 2014-

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A DONATION FROM THE ESTATE OF JOSEPH LEVY IN THE AMOUNT OF FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$5,000), TO BE DEPOSITED INTO THE BROWARD COUNTY LIBRARY TRUST FUND FOR THE USE AND BENEFIT OF THE BROWARD COUNTY NORTH REGIONAL LIBRARY; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO SIGN THE RECEIPT OF BENEFICIARY AND CONSENT TO DISCHARGE AND TO TAKE ALL ADMINISTRATIVE AND BUDGETARY ACTIONS TO IMPLEMENT SAME; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Cheryl Buckner, Esquire, Personal Representative for the Estate of Joseph Levy, desires to donate Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000) to Broward County, for deposit into the Broward County Library Trust Fund for the use and benefit of the Broward County North Regional Library; and

WHEREAS, Section 18.63 of the Broward County Administrative Code provides for the acceptance and acknowledgement by the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida ("Board"), of donations to the County that are valued at Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) or more; and

WHEREAS, the Board wishes to accept this generous donation, and to express its gratitude for such donation, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

1 Section 1. The Board hereby accepts a Five Thousand Dollar (\$5,000)  
2 donation from Cheryl Bucker, Esquire, as Personal Representative for the Estate of  
3 Joseph Levy, 2758 East Atlantic Boulevard, Pompano Beach, FL 33062, for deposit into  
4 the Library Trust Fund Account for the use and benefit of the Broward County North  
5 Regional Library.

6 Section 2. The Board hereby authorizes the County Administrator to execute  
7 on behalf of Broward County, the Receipt of Beneficiary and Consent to Discharge for  
8 the Estate of Joseph Levy, and to take all administrative and budgetary actions, and  
9 execute all forms required to implement acceptance of the donation in this matter.

10 Section 3. SEVERABILITY.

11 If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any Court to be invalid, the  
12 invalid portion shall be stricken, and such striking shall not affect the validity of the  
13 remainder of this Resolution. If any Court determines that this Resolution, or any  
14 portion hereof, cannot be legally applied to any individual(s), group(s), entity(ies),  
15 property(ies), or circumstance(s), such determination shall not affect the applicability  
16 hereof to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

17 Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

18 This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
