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RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY OF BROWARD COUNTY, COMMISSIONERS FLORIDA. RELATING **ECONOMIC** DEVELOPMENT TO RECOMMENDING APPROVAL OF THE APPLICATION OF CORPORATION REFERRED TO AS PROJECT SUPREME PURSUANT TO SECTION 288.075, FLORIDA STATUTES, THAT PROJECT SUPREME BE APPROVED QUALIFIED **TARGET** INDUSTRY **BUSINESS** APPLICANT PURSUANT TO SECTION 288.106, FLORIDA STATUTES, AND AS A QUALIFIED TARGET INDUSTRY HIGH **IMPACT** SECTOR BUSINESS APPLICANT PURSUANT TO SECTION 288.108, FLORIDA STATUTES: PROVIDING AN APPROPRIATION OF TWO HUNDRED FORTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$240,000) AS BROWARD COUNTY'S LOCAL MATCH FOR THE TARGET INDUSTRY TAX REFUND AND THE QUALIFIED TARGET INDUSTRY HIGH-IMPACT SECTOR BONUS TAX **REFUND PROGRAMS** FOR **FISCAL YEARS SUPREME** THROUGH 2019; **THAT PROJECT BROWARD** APPROVED AS COUNTY DIRECT CASH/JOB CREATION INCENTIVE GRANT APPLICANT PURSUANT TO SECTION 91/2-52, BROWARD COUNTY FLORIDA CODE OF ORDINANCES ("CODE"); PROVIDING AN APPROPRIATION OF ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND **FOR** CASH/JOB DOLLARS (\$100,000) DIRECT CREATION INCENTIVÉ GRANT FOR FISCAL YEARS 2015 THROUGH 2018; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the corporation referred to as Project Supreme, for the purpose of this Resolution, has requested that Broward County maintain the confidentiality of its name and business information pursuant to Section 288.075, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, Project Supreme, a company specializing in comprehensive human resource and people management software solutions, currently headquartered in the City of Weston, Florida, is now considering expansion of its headquarters in the City of Weston, Florida; and

WHEREAS, Project Supreme is requesting certification as a "Qualified Target Industry Business" under the State of Florida Qualified Target Industry Tax Refund Program ("QTI") pursuant to Section 288.106, Florida Statutes, and the Qualified Target Industry High-Impact Sector Bonus Tax Refund Program ("QTI High-Impact Sector Bonus Tax Refund") pursuant to Section 288.108, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, Project Supreme is requesting support from the Broward County Board of County Commissioners for its QTI and QTI High-Impact Sector Bonus Tax Refund application; and

WHEREAS, Project Supreme has applied for a Direct Cash/Job Creation Incentive Grant from Broward County, Florida pursuant to Section 9½-52 of the Code of Ordinances of Broward County, Florida ("Code"), NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida (the "Board"), hereby recommends that Project Supreme be approved as a QTI Business pursuant to Section 288.106, Florida Statutes, and a QTI High-Impact Sector Business pursuant to Section 288.108, Florida Statutes.

Section 2. The Board hereby recommends and approves the necessary commitment of local financial support for Project Supreme as a Qualified Target Industry Business under the QTI and QTI High-Impact Sector Tax Refund Bonus Programs in the amount of Two Hundred Forty Thousand Dollars (\$240,000), for fiscal years 2015 through 2018, subject to the condition precedent that the City of Weston has

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committed to providing the required local financial QTI match of Two Hundred Forty Thousand Dollars (\$240,000). The County's commitment for local financial support will be paid to the Florida Economic Development Trust Fund with the stipulation that these funds are intended to represent the "local financial support" required by Section 288.106, Florida Statutes.

Section 3. The Board hereby recommends and approves a Direct Cash/Job Creation Incentive Grant in the amount of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) for fiscal years 2015 through 2018, through the County's Direct Cash/Job Creation Incentive Grant Program.

Section 4. In furtherance of Project Supreme's request for approval herein, the Board has determined that the basis of this proposed project's private sector wage commitment calculation shall be 150% of the Broward County average annual wage.

Section 5. The amounts authorized herein shall constitute the County's total commitment to this project for participation in the QTI, and the QTI-High Impact Sector Bonus Tax Refund and Direct Cash/Job Creation Incentive Programs.

Section 6. <u>SEVERABILITY</u>.

If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any Court to be invalid, the invalid portion shall be stricken, and such striking shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Resolution. If any Court determines that this Resolution, or any portion hereof, cannot be legally applied to any individual(s), group(s), entity(ies), property(ies), or circumstance(s), such determination shall not affect the applicability hereof to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.
