RESOLUTION OF THE **BOARD** OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, 2014-2015 APPROVING BROWARD COUNTY'S FY ANNUAL ACTION PLAN FOR OCTOBER 1, 2014, TO SEPTEMBER 30, 2015, FOR THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF DEVELOPMENT HOUSING AND URBAN (HUD) (40TH) **FORTIETH** YEAR GRANT ("PROGRAMS **APPROVING** ESTIMATED **FUNDING** VARIOUS AMOUNTS FROM THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT (CDBG) PROGRAM. THE BLOCK GRANT HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIPS (HOME) PROGRAM, AND **EMERGENCY** SOLUTIONS **GRANTS** (ESG) THE **AUTHORIZING** COUNTY PROGRAM: THE ADMINISTRATOR TO TRANSMIT THE ANNUAL ACTION TAKE NECESSARY HUD. TO ALL PLAN TO ADMINISTRATIVE ACTIONS FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF PROGRAMS, TO MODIFY THE ALLOCATION AMOUNTS BASED ON CHANGES IN THE COUNTY'S AND FINAL GRANT ALLOCATION FROM HUD. AGREEMENTS AND **AMENDMENTS** EXECUTE THE THERETO FOR THE RESPECTIVE PROGRAMS; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD"), pursuant to Title 24, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 91, requires the submission of a Consolidated Plan and an Annual Action Plan by the County, as a grantee applying for funds under the Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") Program, the HOME Investment Partnerships ("HOME") Program, and the Emergency Solutions Grants ("ESG") Program, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein as if set forth in full hereunder.

Section 2. The Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida ("Board"), approves the FY 2014-2015 Annual Action Plan ("Plan") and the estimated funding for the Programs as follows: CDBG Program in the amount of Two Million Three Hundred Sixty-nine Thousand Five Hundred Eighty-seven Dollars (\$2,369,587), In addition to Fifty-one Thousand Three Hundred Thirty-eight Dollars (\$51,338) reallocated from FY 2013-2014, and One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) in Program Income; HOME Program in the amount of Two Million Six Hundred Fourteen Thousand Nine Hundred Forty-four Dollars (\$2,614,944), in addition to Two Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$230,000) in Program Income; and an ESG Program in the amount of One Hundred Ninety-five Thousand Seven Hundred Ninety-four Dollars (\$195,794).

- Section 3. The Board approves the proposed subrecipients of funding under the Plan, including projects and project amounts, set forth in Attachment "1," attached hereto and made a part hereof, for FY 2014-2015 for the CDBG, HOME, and ESG Programs, and CDBG and HOME Program Income.
- Section 4. The County Administrator is authorized to transmit the Plan to HUD and take all necessary administrative actions for implementation of the HUD Fortieth (40th) Year grant programs.
- Section 5. The County Administrator is authorized to increase or decrease the estimated funding amounts and project service deliverables for the projects set forth in Attachment "1," due to changes in the County's final grant allocation from HUD.

1 The County Administrator is authorized to revise projects set forth Section 6. in Attachment "1," with subrecipients of funding, provided the new projects consist of eligible activities under the applicable rules and regulations of HUD. 3 The County Administrator is authorized to execute agreements for Section 7. 4 the respective programs in forms approved by the Office of the County Attorney, which 5 shall include all standard agreement provisions, and to execute amendments thereto. 6 7 Section 8. SEVERABILITY. If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any Court to be invalid, the 8 invalid portion shall be stricken, and such striking shall not affect the validity of the 9 remainder of this Resolution. If any Court determines that this Resolution, or any 10 portion hereof, cannot be legally applied to any individual(s), group(s), entity(ies), 11 property(ies), or circumstance(s), such determination shall not affect the applicability 12 hereof to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance. 13 14 Section 9. EFFECTIVE DATE.
