Dear Mr. Stone,

On behalf of the Board of Directors of Offerdahl's Hand-Off Foundation we respectfully request a resolution passed by the Broward County Board of Commissioners to allow Offerdahl's Hand-Off Foundation, Inc. to be considered as an agency that would qualify for the Community Contribution Tax Credits (CCTC).

Home Team Advantage (HTA) is a program that provides restorative housing for low to very low income individuals and families in need. HTA is meant to match families in crisis with short to long-term housing and a vitally needed community support system.

More specifically, HTA would connect housing and case management services with social support systems for those in need. This support system is provided by nonprofit Social Support System Beneficiary Organizations (SSSBOs) that intrinsically and intentionally provides love, compassion & accountability into restoring broken relationships.

Offerdahl's Hand-Off Foundation mission is to "Feed the Needs of Kids in Crisis" who are hungry, homeless & hurting through faith-based, business & government partnerships. Specific focus is on the fatherless and the homeless.

Upon receiving the resolution, Offerdahl's Hand-Off Foundation intends to submit a proposal for the HTA program to the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity to allow the solicitation of financial sponsorship and in-kind donation of housing units. As part of its proposal, HTA is required to submit a Resolution from the Broward County Commission, certifying that HTA program is consistent with local plans (Broward County Consolidated Plan and Comprehensive Plan) and regulations. This request for resolution does not require any financial investment by the County.
