## RESOLUTION NO. 2017- 301

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE BROWARD COUNTY LEAGUE OF CITIES OPPOSING THE DISSOLUTION OF THE BROWARD COUNTY CONSOLIDATED COMMUNICATIONS COMMITTEE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Broward County Consolidated Communications Committee ("BCCCC") has not only been a sounding board for the stakeholders, but also a place for the public to provide input on the regional E911 system; and

WHEREAS, the BCCCC has held the Office of Regional Communication and Technology and the Broward Sheriff's Office accountable, inspired changes to performance reporting, supported the need for quality assurance improvements, challenged reporting on radio upgrades and system failures and generated a sustained oversight model; and

WHEREAS, the County Administrator has proposed the dissolution, or sunset, of the BCCCC based upon an interpretation of a recent consultant report that recommended various changes could be accomplished over the next twelve (12) months through joint efforts from Broward County and the Broward Sheriff's Office; and

WHEREAS, the effort to sunset the BCCC comes at a time where the new regional CAD and radio systems, as well as new suggestions for conflict resolution and/or governance, staffing improvements, and other system changes, have not yet been implemented; and

WHEREAS, at the Broward League of Cities meeting with Fitch & Associates, it was agreed that the BCCCC should not be sunset or dissolved until the recommended changes are implemented; and

WHEREAS, on January 25, 2017, the BCCCC voted 7-1 to continue the work of the BCCCC for at least the next year, with the only dissenting vote cast by the County Administrator's Office representative; and

WHEREAS, the sunset of the BCCCC at this time would roll back transparency, oversight and accountability efforts, or certainly make efforts dedicated to such far more difficult and less effective.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** the Board of Directors of the Broward League of Cities hereby resolves as follows:

- Section 1. The foregoing "Whereas clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.
- Section 2. The Board of Directors of the Broward County League of Cities opposes any effort to sunset or dissolve of the Broward County Consolidated Communications Committee at this time and until such time as recommended changes have been fully implemented where feasible and implemented changes are evaluated over a meaningful period of time.
- **Section 3.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption its passage and adoption.
