


On December 4, 2012, the Claimant, a former Mosquito Control Specialist I, sustained an injury during the course and scope of employment the Broward County Highway and Bridge Maintenance Division, Mosquito Control Section. The Claimant alleged injuries to the left foot, lumbar spine, cervical spine, left shoulder, and head after a motor vehicle accident. The Claimant was terminated on April 2, 2014.


Through negotiations with the Claimant, a settlement was reached in the total amount of \$27,500. This amount is broken down as follows: (1) The Claimant will receive \$23,200, plus \$500 for a Release and Resignation Agreement; and (2) the Claimant's attorney will receive \$3,450 for fees and \$350 for costs. The settlement includes all future indemnity and medical benefits.

CONCURRENCE

Based on the factual information provided, the Office of the County Attorney concurs in the proposed settlement. This concurrence meets the requirements of Section 1-51.3(2)(c), Broward County Code of Ordinances.

This concurrence does not reflect our independent assessment of Broward County's actual risk or financial exposure, which may change if additional information is learned through litigation or other subsequent events.
