# 15. Termination and Cancellation Provisions

For Cause: THIS AGREEMENT MAY BE TERMINATED FOR CAUSE BASED ON ANY BREACH THAT IS NOT CURED WITHIN TEN (10) DAYS AFTER WRITTEN NOTICE FROM THE AGGRIEVED PARTY IDENTIFYING THE BREACH.

For Convenience: THIS AGREEMENT MAY ALSO BE TERMINATED FOR CONVENIENCE BY THE BOARD UPON PROVIDING WRITTEN NOTICE TO PROVIDER OF THE TERMINATION DATE, WHICH SHALL BE NOT LESS THAN THIRTY (30) DAYS AFTER THE DATE SUCH WRITTEN NOTICE IS PROVIDED. IF COUNTY ERRONEOUSLY, IMPROPERLY, OR UNJUSTIFIABLY TERMINATES FOR CAUSE, SUCH TERMINATION SHALL, TO THE FULL EXTEND PERMISSIBLE UNDER APPLICABLE LAW, BE DEEMED A TERMINATION FOR CONVENIENCE, WHICH SHALL BE EFFECTIVE THIRTY (30) DAYS AFTER SUCH NOTICE OF TERMINATION FOR CAUSE IDS PROVIDED.

16. Deliverables, milestones or scope of this action:

County may acquire any Equipment manufactured by or for, Check Point Software Technologies, LTD, branded under the Check Point name or any other official branding associated with Check Point Software Technologies, Ltd. by issuance of an appropriate Purchase Order or Work Authorization. County is under no obligation to purchase any given quantity or product(s) at any time. County reserves the right to utilize any other County contract, any State of Florida contract, any contract awarded by any other city or county governmental agencies, school boards, other community college/state university system cooperative agreements, or to directly negotiate/purchase per County policy, in lieu of purchasing any good or service under this Agreement.

- 17. List terms, considerations or deviations from standard county form.
- The primary technology is being provided by subcontractor Check Point Software Technologies Ltd. Therefore, Services and support may be provided by Check Point, and compliance with County's indemnification and security requirements may be met by the performance of Check Point.
- 2. Additional equipment may be acquired by purchase order; purchase of software and additional services will require an executed Work Authorization.
- Current subscriptions are not subject to acceptance testing; any subsequently procured software will be subject to acceptance testing and the Work Authorization will state the applicable final acceptance test criteria.
