2 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY
3 COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA,
4 ACCEPTING A DONATION OF FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS
5 (\$500) FROM SCOTT RUBINCHIK, A PRIVATE CITIZEN, FOR
6 THE BENEFIT OF THE BROWARD ADDICTION RECOVERY
7 DIVISION AND ITS CLIENTS; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY
ADMINISTRATOR TO TAKE ALL ADMINISTRATIVE AND
BUDGETARY ACTIONS REQUIRED TO IMPLEMENT
ACCEPTANCE; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND
AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

8 WHEREAS, Scott Rubinchik, a private citizen of Broward County, has most
9 generously donated Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) to the Broward Addiction Recovery
10 Division ("BARC"), for substance abuse treatment programs to benefit BARC and its
11 clients; and

12 WHEREAS, Section 18.63 of the Broward County Administrative Code provides
13 for the acceptance and acknowledgement by the Board of County Commissioners of
14 Broward County, Florida ("Board"), of donations to the County that are valued at
15 Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) or more; and

16 WHEREAS, the Board wishes to accept the generous gift, and to express its
17 gratitude for such donation, NOW, THEREFORE,

19 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
20 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

22 Section 1. The Board hereby accepts a donation of Five Hundred Dollars
23 (\$500) to the Broward Addiction Recovery Division, Alcoholism Trust Fund from Scott
24 Rubinchik, whose local address is 1860 North Pine Island Road, Suite 201,

1 Plantation, Florida 33322, for substance abuse treatment programs to benefit BARC
2 and its clients.

3 Section 2. The County Administrator is authorized to take all administrative
4 and budgetary actions required to implement acceptance of the donation in this matter.

5 Section 3. SEVERABILITY.

6 If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any Court to be invalid, the
7 invalid portion shall be stricken, and such striking shall not affect the validity of the
8 remainder of this Resolution. If any Court determines that this Resolution, or any portion
9 hereof, cannot be legally applied to any individual(s), group(s), entity(ies), property(ies),
10 or circumstance(s), such determination shall not affect the applicability hereof to any
11 other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

12 Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

13 This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
