RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY. FLORIDA. PERTAINING TO **FEES** FOR GROUND TRANSPORTATION SERVICES AT FORT LAUDERDALE-HOLLYWOOD INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT: AMENDING SECTION 39.2 OF THE **BROWARD** COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE ("ADMINISTRATIVE ESTABLISHING A PICK-UP FEE OF THREE DOLLAR **TRANSPORTATION** PICK-UP FOR COMPANIES: UPDATING THE PAYMENT PROCEDURES PREARRANGED VEHICLES AND COURTESY PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY. VEHICLES: AND INCLUSION IN THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, during the 2017 legislative session, the Florida Legislature approved HB 221, which allows airports to charge reasonable pick-up fees to transportation network companies consistent with any pick-up fees charged to taxicab companies for their use of the airport's facilities; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 39 of the Broward County Administrative Code, which outlines the fees and charges at Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport ("Airport"), provides that taxicabs shall be required to pay a trip fee in the amount of Three Dollars (\$3) per trip; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida, finds that transportation network companies shall similarly be required to pay a pick-up fee in the amount of Three Dollars (\$3) per pick-up for their use of the Airport's facilities; and

WHEREAS, the payment procedures for prearranged vehicles and courtesy vehicles must be updated now that the Airport is using automatic vehicle identification ("AVI") technology, NOW, THEREFORE,
