2 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY  
3 COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA,  
4 PERTAINING TO FEES FOR GROUND  
5 TRANSPORTATION SERVICES AT FORT LAUDERDALE-  
6 HOLLYWOOD INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT; AMENDING  
7 SECTION 39.2 OF THE BROWARD COUNTY  
8 ADMINISTRATIVE CODE ("ADMINISTRATIVE CODE");  
9 ESTABLISHING A PICK-UP FEE OF THREE DOLLARS  
PER PICK-UP FOR TRANSPORTATION NETWORK  
COMPANIES; UPDATING THE PAYMENT PROCEDURES  
FOR PREARRANGED VEHICLES AND COURTESY  
VEHICLES; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY,  
INCLUSION IN THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, AND AN  
EFFECTIVE DATE.

10 WHEREAS, during the 2017 legislative session, the Florida Legislature approved  
11 HB 221, which allows airports to charge reasonable pick-up fees to transportation  
12 network companies consistent with any pick-up fees charged to taxicab companies for  
13 their use of the airport's facilities; and

14 WHEREAS, Chapter 39 of the Broward County Administrative Code, which  
15 outlines the fees and charges at Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport  
16 ("Airport"), provides that taxicabs shall be required to pay a trip fee in the amount of  
17 Three Dollars (\$3) per trip; and

18 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida,  
19 finds that transportation network companies shall similarly be required to pay a pick-up  
20 fee in the amount of Three Dollars (\$3) per pick-up for their use of the Airport's facilities;  
21 and

22 WHEREAS, the payment procedures for prearranged vehicles and courtesy  
23 vehicles must be updated now that the Airport is using automatic vehicle identification  
24 ("AVI") technology, NOW, THEREFORE,

2 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF  
3 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

5 Section 1. Section 39.2 of the Broward County Administrative Code is hereby  
6 amended to read as follows:

7 **39.2. Rates, Fees, and Charges—Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International**  
8 **Airport.**

10 g. Fees for Providing Ground Transportation Services.

12 4. Prearranged Vehicles and Courtesy Vehicles Payment of Trip  
13 Fees.

14 a) ~~All per trip fees for the previous month's Ground~~  
15 ~~Transportation Services shall be due and payable to the~~  
16 ~~Aviation Department by the fifteenth (15th) day of each~~  
17 ~~month. Each permittee shall provide a statement certified by~~  
18 ~~one of its officers setting forth the number of permittee's trips~~  
19 ~~at the Airport during the prior month. Payment for the~~

4                   8. Transportation network company fees.

5                   a)   Transportation network companies, as defined by state law,  
6                   shall be required to pay a fee of Three Dollars (\$3) per pick-  
7                   up.

8                   b)   Unless otherwise agreed to by the Airport and the  
9                   transportation network company, all pick-up fees for the  
10                  previous month's Ground Transportation Services shall be  
11                  due and payable to the Aviation Department by the fifteenth  
12                  (15th) day of each month. Each transportation network  
13                  company shall provide a statement certified by one of its  
14                  officers setting forth the number of the transportation  
15                  network company's pick-ups at the Airport during the prior  
16                  month. Payment for the preceding month's pick-up fees  
17                  shall be remitted to the Aviation Department with each  
18                  monthly statement.

20                  Section 2.   SEVERABILITY.

21                  If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any Court to be invalid, the  
22                  invalid portion shall be stricken, and such striking shall not affect the validity of the
