GRANTING RENEWAL OF A NONEXCLUSIVE FRANCHISE 4 TO AFCO AGENCY USA LLC FOR A TEN-YEAR TERM TO **STEVEDORE SERVICES PROVIDE** AΤ PORT 5 EVERGLADES: PROVIDING AND FOR NONDISCRIMINATION, COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE 6 LAW, SEVERABILITY, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 7 8 WHEREAS, the Broward County Board of County Commissioners (the "Board") adopted Resolution No. 94-1302 creating Chapter 32 of the Broward County 10 Administrative Code, effective November 22, 1994, to provide for the regulation of 11 businesses requiring franchises to conduct operations at Port Everglades; and 12 WHEREAS, AFCO Agency USA LLC has submitted an application for a franchise, 13 and the Board has relied on the representations of AFCO Agency USA LLC, and reviewed the application in light of the requirements of Chapter 32 of the Broward County 14 Administrative Code; and 15 WHEREAS, the public hearing required for this franchise was conducted on 16 17 August 22, 2017; and 18 WHEREAS, based on representations of AFCO Agency USA LLC, and information 19 presented by County staff and the public, the Board does hereby find, determine, and 20 declare the franchise to be in the public interest, NOW, THEREFORE, 21 22 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF 23 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

The foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are true and correct and hereby Section 1. ratified by the Board of County Commissioners.

AWARD OF FRANCHISE TO AFCO AGENCY USA LLC. Section 2.

AFCO Agency USA LLC is hereby granted renewal of a nonexclusive franchise to provide stevedore services at Port Everglades.

Section 3. TERM.

The franchise shall be for a period of ten (10) years, commencing on September 27, 2017, and ending on September 26, 2027, unless sooner terminated in accordance with the provisions of the franchise, including Section 32.29 of the Broward County Administrative Code.

Section 4. NONDISCRIMINATION/APPLICABLE LAW.

By accepting this nonexclusive franchise, AFCO Agency USA LLC agrees that the effectiveness of the franchise is subject to strict compliance with the Broward County Human Rights Act (Chapter 16½, Broward County Code of Ordinances), and all rules, regulations, and ordinances, including the Broward County Administrative Code and Code of Ordinances, now or hereafter promulgated by Broward County pertaining to the conduct of the business operated pursuant to this franchise, and is also subject to the terms and provisions of all federal and state laws, as amended from time to time, affecting the conduct of the business for which AFCO Agency USA LLC is hereby franchised. The imposition and enforcement of such laws to which this franchise shall be subject shall operate uniformly with respect to all persons, firms, or corporations holding similar franchises within Port Everglades.
