#### ORDINANCE NO. 2017-

1 AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF  
2 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING AN AMENDMENT TO THE  
3 BROWARD COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN BY AMENDING THE  
4 BROWARD COUNTY LAND USE PLAN TEXT REGARDING THE CITY OF  
PEMBROKE PINES ACTIVITY CENTER; AND PROVIDING FOR  
SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

5 (Sponsored by the Board of County Commissioners)

6 WHEREAS, Broward County adopted the Broward County Comprehensive Plan  
7 on April 25, 2017 (the Plan); and

8 WHEREAS, the Department of Economic Opportunity has found the Plan in  
9 compliance with the Community Planning Act; and

10 WHEREAS, Broward County now wishes to propose an amendment to the Land  
11 Use Plan Text of the Plan; and

12 WHEREAS, the Planning Council, as the local planning agency for the Broward  
13 County Land Use Plan, held its hearings on February 23, 2017, and May 25, 2017, with  
14 due public notice; and

15 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners held its transmittal public hearing  
16 on March 28, 2017, having complied with the notice requirements specified in Section  
17 163.3184(11), Florida Statutes; and

18 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners held an adoption public hearing  
19 on August 22, 2017, at 10:00 a.m. [also complying with the notice requirements specified  
20 in Section 163.3184(11), Florida Statutes] at which public comment was accepted, and  
21 the comments of the Department of Economic Opportunity, South Florida Regional  
22 Planning Council, South Florida Water Management District, Department of  
23 Environmental Protection, Department of State, Department of Transportation, Fish and

1 Wildlife Conservation Commission, Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services,  
2 and Department of Education, as applicable, were considered; and

3 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, after due consideration of all  
4 matters, hereby finds that the following amendment to the Broward County  
5 Comprehensive Plan is consistent with the State Plan, and the Broward County  
6 Comprehensive Plan; complies with the requirements of the Community Planning Act;  
7 and is in the best interests of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of Broward  
8 County,

9 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF  
10 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

11 Section 1. The Broward County Comprehensive Plan is hereby amended by  
12 Amendment PCT 17-2, which is an amendment to the Broward County Land Use Plan  
13 Text for the City of Pembroke Pines Activity Center, as set forth in Exhibit "A," attached  
14 hereto and incorporated herein.

15 Section 2. SEVERABILITY.

16 If any portion of this Ordinance is determined by any Court to be invalid, the invalid  
17 portion shall be stricken, and such striking shall not affect the validity of the remainder of  
18 this Ordinance. If any Court determines that this Ordinance, or any portion hereof, cannot  
19 be legally applied to any individual(s), group(s), entity(ies), property(ies), or  
20 circumstance(s), such determination shall not affect the applicability hereof to any other  
21 individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

22 Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.

23 (a) The effective date of the plan amendment set forth in this Ordinance shall  
24 be the latter of:

1 (1) Thirty-one (31) days after the Department of Economic Opportunity notifies  
2 Broward County that the plan amendment is complete;

3 (2) If the plan amendment is challenged, the date a final order is entered by the  
4 Administration Commission or the Department of Economic Opportunity  
5 finding the amendment to be in compliance; or

6 (3) If the Department of Economic Opportunity or the Administration  
7 Commission finds the amendment to be in noncompliance, pursuant to  
8 Section 163.3184(8)(b), Florida Statutes, the date the Board of County  
9 Commissioners, nonetheless, elects to make the plan amendment effective  
10 notwithstanding potential statutory sanctions.

11 (b) This Ordinance shall become effective as provided by law.
