2 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY
3 COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA,
4 ACCEPTING A DONATION OF FIVE HUNDRED THIRTY
5 DOLLARS (\$530) FROM SOUTHERN GAS ASSOCIATION
6 AND AMEC FOSTER WHEELER TO BE DEPOSITED IN THE
7 FRIENDS OF THE PARKS AND RECREATION DIVISION
8 TRUST FUND TO AUGMENT EDUCATIONAL AMENITIES
9 PROVIDED BY THE PARKS AND RECREATION DIVISION;
10 AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO TAKE
11 ALL ADMINISTRATIVE AND BUDGETARY ACTIONS
12 REQUIRED TO IMPLEMENT ACCEPTANCE; AND
13 PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE
14 DATE.

15 WHEREAS, Southern Gas Association and AMEC Foster Wheeler have jointly
16 donated Five Hundred Thirty Dollars (\$530) to be deposited in The Friends of the Parks
17 and Recreation Division Trust Fund to augment educational amenities provided by the
18 Parks and Recreation Division; and

19 WHEREAS, Section 18.63 of the Broward County Administrative Code provides
20 for the acceptance and acknowledgement by the Board of County Commissioners of
21 Broward County, Florida ("Board"), of donations to the County that are valued at
22 Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) or more; and

23 WHEREAS, the Board wishes to accept the generous gift, and to express its
24 gratitude for such donation, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Board hereby accepts a joint donation from Southern Gas
Association, whose address is 3030 LBJ Freeway, Suite 1500, Dallas, Texas 75234,
and AMEC Foster Wheeler, whose address is 110 East Broward Boulevard,

1 Suite 1749, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33301, to be deposited in The Friends of the
2 Parks and Recreation Division Trust Fund to augment educational amenities provided
3 by the Parks and Recreation Division.

4 Section 2. The County Administrator is authorized to take all administrative
5 and budgetary actions required to implement acceptance of the donation in this matter.

6 Section 3. SEVERABILITY.

7 If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any Court to be invalid, the
8 invalid portion shall be stricken, and such striking shall not affect the validity of the
9 remainder of this Resolution. If any Court determines that this Resolution, or any
10 portion hereof, cannot be legally applied to any individual(s), group(s), entity(ies),
11 property(ies), or circumstance(s), such determination shall not affect the applicability
12 hereof to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

13 Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

14 This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
