2 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY
3 COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA,
4 AUTHORIZING THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION
5 AND GROWTH MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT TO FILE A
6 LONG-RANGE BEACH EROSION CONTROL FUNDING
7 REQUEST WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF
8 ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION FOR PROJECTS TO
9 MITIGATE BEACH EROSION IN BROWARD COUNTY;
10 SUPPORTING PROJECTS FOR WHICH FUNDING IS
11 REQUESTED; CONFIRMING BROWARD COUNTY'S
12 ABILITY TO SERVE AS LOCAL SPONSOR AND FUND
13 THE APPROPRIATE LOCAL SHARE OF PROJECTS;
14 IDENTIFYING THE SOURCE OF COUNTY SHARE; AND
15 PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE
16 DATE.

17 WHEREAS, public works projects and studies relating to beach erosion control,
18 beach preservation, marine environmental protection, and hurricane protection are
19 eligible for State of Florida ("State") funding consideration under the provisions of
20 Chapter 161, Florida Statutes; and

21 WHEREAS, in order to qualify for State beach project funding, current State
22 policy requires submission of a long-range local government funding request which
23 coordinates projects relating to beach erosion within the entity's boundaries; and

24 WHEREAS, inlet sand bypassing and beach erosion control projects using
compatible materials, including nearshore, offshore, and upland sand, have been, and
are planned to be, conducted by Broward County as local project sponsor, with
subsequent reimbursement of the federal and State shares of eligible costs; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County has
determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Broward County to pursue all

1 available funding in order to restore and maintain the beaches of Broward County,
2 NOW, THEREFORE,

4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
5 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

7 Section 1. The Broward County Environmental Protection and Growth
8 Management Department is authorized and directed to file a long-range local
9 government funding request with the Florida Department of Environmental Protection.

11 Section 2. The Broward County Board of County Commissioners supports the
12 beach erosion control projects for which funding is requested from the State of Florida,
13 as set forth in the accompanying agenda report.

15 Section 3. Broward County is able to serve as local sponsor for beach erosion
16 control projects and is able to provide the appropriate local funding share from beach
17 capital funds to implement the projects.

19 Section 4. SEVERABILITY.

20 If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any Court to be invalid, the
21 invalid portion shall be stricken, and such striking shall not affect the validity of the
22 remainder of this Resolution. If any Court determines that this Resolution, or any
23 portion hereof, cannot be legally applied to any individual(s), group(s), entity(ies),

1 property(ies), or circumstance(s), such determination shall not affect the applicability
2 hereof to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.
