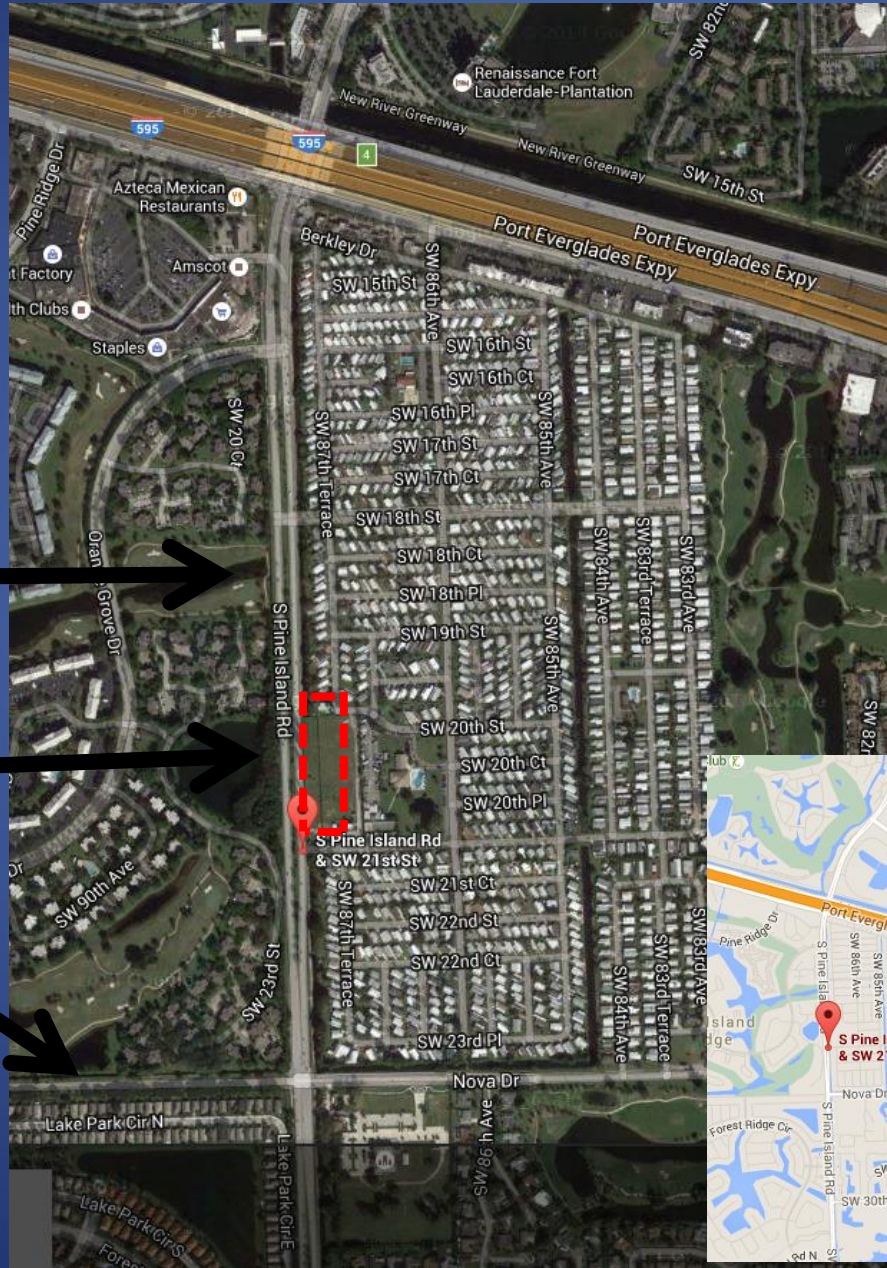


Project Site – Pine Island Pocket Park



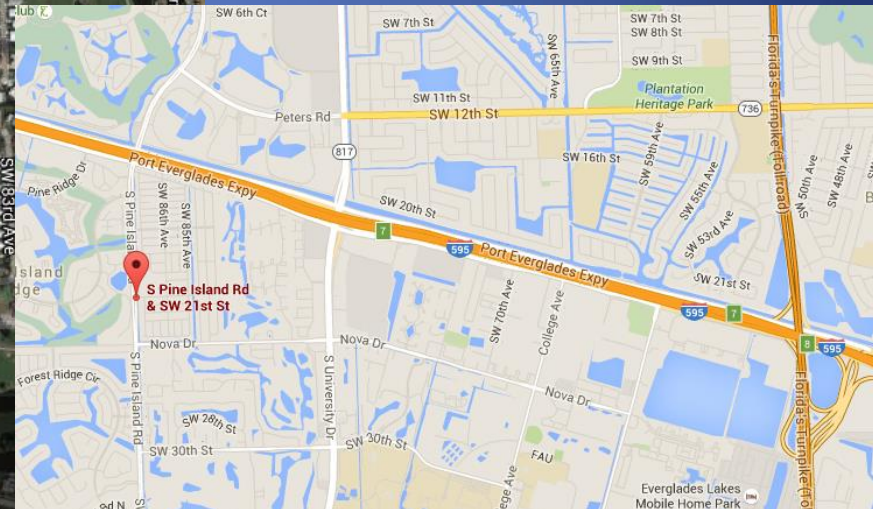
- East side of South Pine Island Road, between SW 18th and SW 21st Streets in the Town of Davie

Nova Drive

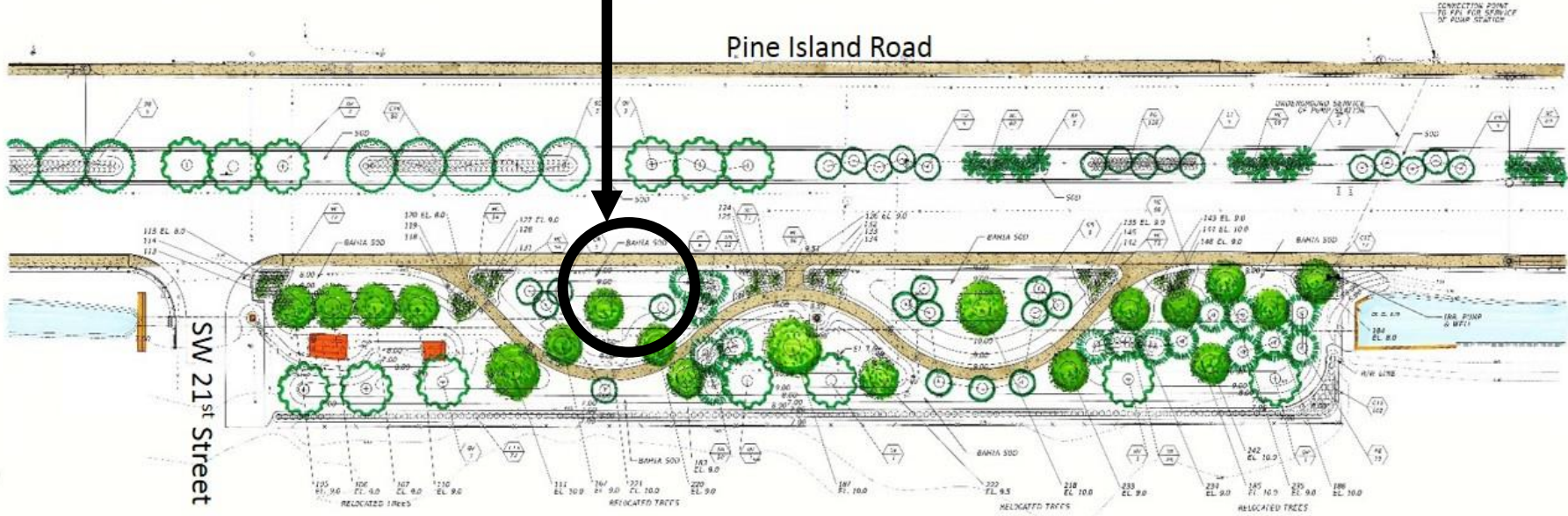


Gareth Curtiss - Location
