2 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY
3 COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA,
4 ACCEPTING A DONATION OF NINETY (90) ANDROID
5 ALCATEL EIGHT-INCH TABLETS, AND NINETY (90)
6 ALCATEL HOTSPOTS, AT A COMBINED VALUE OF
7 NINETEEN THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED NINETY-
8 EIGHT DOLLARS AND TWENTY CENTS (\$19,798.20),
9 FROM T-MOBILE; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY
10 ADMINISTRATOR TO TAKE ALL ADMINISTRATIVE AND
11 BUDGETARY ACTIONS TO IMPLEMENT ACCEPTANCE;
12 AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN
13 EFFECTIVE DATE.

14 WHEREAS, T-Mobile has generously offered to donate to the County 90 Android
15 Alcatel 8-inch Tablets and 90 Alcatel Hotspots, at a combined value of \$19,798.20, and
16 to provide discounted data rates for the County's Digital Divide Program and the
17 Broward County Libraries Division program to provide Veterans, active military
18 members, and their dependents with connectivity and accessibility to the Division's
19 resources; and

20 WHEREAS, Section 18.63 of the Broward County Administrative Code provides
21 for the acceptance and acknowledgement by the Board of County Commissioners of
22 Broward County, Florida ("Board"), of donations to the County that are valued at Five
23 Hundred Dollars (\$500) or more; and

24 WHEREAS, the Board wishes to accept the generous gift, and to express its
gratitude for such donation, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

1 Section 1. The Board hereby accepts the donation of the 90 Alcatel Tablets
2 and 90 Alcatel Hotspots.

3 Section 2. The County Administrator is hereby authorized to take all
4 administrative and budgetary actions and execute all forms required to implement
5 acceptance of the donation and expenditure of the funds in this matter.

6 Section 3. SEVERABILITY.

7 If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any Court to be invalid, the
8 invalid portion shall be stricken, and such striking shall not affect the validity of the
9 remainder of this Resolution. If any Court determines that this Resolution, or any
10 portion hereof, cannot be legally applied to any individual(s), group(s), entity(ies),
11 property(ies), or circumstance(s), such determination shall not affect the applicability
12 hereof to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

13 Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

14 This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
