RESOLUTION OF BOARD OF COUNTY THE COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY. PERTAINING TO THE INDEPENDENT ANNUAL AUDIT AMENDING SECTION 18.61 OF THE BROWARD COUNTY ("ADMINISTRATIVE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE REGARDING THE ENGAGEMENT OF AN AUDITOR AND SELECTION PROCEDURES; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 2.11 of the Broward County Charter requires that the Board of County Commissioners provide for an independent annual audit of the accounts and financial transactions of the County; and

WHEREAS, Section 125.01, Florida Statutes, requires that the Board of County Commissioners employ an independent certified public accountant to perform an annual financial audit of the accounts and financial transactions of the County; and

WHEREAS, Section 218.391, Florida Statutes, establishes certain procedures when selecting an auditor to conduct the annual financial audit; and

WHEREAS, Section 218.391, Florida Statutes, requires the County to establish an audit committee to assist the Board of County Commissioners in selecting an auditor to conduct the annual financial audit, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Section 18.61 of the Broward County Administrative Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

18.61. Independent Annual Audit.

- a. Section 8.10 2.11 of the Broward County Charter requires that the Board of County Commissioners provide for an independent annual audit of the accounts and financial transactions of the County. The contract administrator for the independent annual audit shall be the County Auditor. Section 11.45 125.01, Florida Statutes, requires that the Board of County Commissioners employ an independent certified public accountant to perform an annual financial audit of the accounts and financial transactions of the County.
- b. The following policy shall govern the engagement of external an auditors for an independent annual audit of the accounts and financial transactions of the Board of County Commissioners Broward County: The Administrator is directed to provide for an annual audit of the accounts and finances of the County. The audits shall be performed by external auditors, recommended to and selected by the Board of County Commissioners, through competitive negotiations. As required by Section 218.391, Florida Statutes, the Board of County Commissioners shall establish an audit committee, in accordance with statutory requirements. The audit committee shall follow the auditor selection procedures set forth in the statute and shall rank and recommend auditors in order of preference. The Board of County Commissioners shall make the final determination in the selection of an auditor. The engagement of the external an auditor shall be for a five (5) year term with a mandatory change of auditors after five (5) years.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
