

1 RESOLUTION NO. 2017-

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY
3 COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA,
4 PERTAINING TO WATER AND WASTEWATER
5 SERVICES; AMENDING SECTION 38.19 OF THE
6 BROWARD COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE
7 ("ADMINISTRATIVE CODE") TO PRESCRIBE A REVISED
8 SCHEDULE OF RAW WATER SUPPLY LARGE USER
9 RATES; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY,
10 INCLUSION IN THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, AND AN
11 EFFECTIVE DATE.

12 WHEREAS, Broward County provides raw water supply to large users of the
13 County's Regional Raw Water System pursuant to certain Agreements (the
14 "Agreements"); and

15 WHEREAS, the Agreements require that Broward County review the rates on an
16 annual basis, and Broward County has completed its review accordingly; and

17 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 34-6 of the Broward County Code of
18 Ordinances, the water and wastewater rates, fees, and charges are required to be
19 established following public notice and hearing, which, in this matter, have been
20 satisfied; and

21 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds it is reasonable and in the
22 best interest of the public to revise Section 38.19 of the Broward County Administrative
23 Code to reflect the new rates, fees, and charges for large users of the Regional Raw
24 Water System effective for all services rendered on or after October 1, 2017, NOW,
THEREFORE,

1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
2 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

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4 Section 1. The recitals set forth in the preamble to this Resolution are
5 incorporated by reference herein.

6 Section 2. Section 38.19 of the Broward County Administrative Code is hereby
7 amended to read as follows:

8 **38.19. Raw Water Supply Large User Rates.**

9 The following schedule of rates, fees, and charges for Large Users of the
10 Regional Raw Water System operated by Broward County Water and Wastewater
11 Services is effective with all services rendered on or after October 1, ~~2016~~ 2017:

12	a.	Customer Charge (per account, per month)	\$4.41	<u>\$4.42</u>
13	b.	Operations and Maintenance (per one		
14		thousand (1,000) gallons, all gallons)	\$0.211	<u>\$0.221</u>
15	c.	Monthly Improvement, Repair, and Replacement		
16		Surcharge (<u>all charges</u>)		5%

17 Section 3. SEVERABILITY.

18 If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any Court to be invalid, the
19 invalid portion shall be stricken, and such striking shall not affect the validity of the
20 remainder of this Resolution. If any Court determines that this Resolution, or any
21 portion hereof, cannot be legally applied to any individual(s), group(s), entity(ies),
22 property(ies), or circumstance(s), such determination shall not affect the applicability
23 hereof to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

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Coding: Words in ~~struck-through~~ type are deletions from existing text. Words in underscored type are additions.

1 Section 4. INCLUSION IN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE.

2 It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of
3 this Resolution shall become and be made a part of the Broward County Administrative
4 Code; and that the sections of this Resolution be renumbered or relettered and the word
5 "resolution" may be changed to "section," "article," or such other appropriate word or
6 phrase in order to accomplish such intentions.

7 Section 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.

8 This Resolution shall become effective on October 1, 2017.
