RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING THE CANDIDACY OF BROWARD COUNTY MAYOR BARBARA SHARIEF FOR 2ND VICE PRESIDENT OF THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF COUNTIES; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Florida is the third largest state in the nation, representing more than 19 million people in 67 counties; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Association of Counties ("FAC") helps counties effectively serve and represent Floridians by strengthening and preserving county home rule through advocacy, education, and collaboration; and

WHEREAS, for more than 80 years, the FAC has represented the diverse interests of Florida's counties, emphasizing the importance of protecting home rule, the concept that local leaders should make the decisions that impact their local communities; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners calls upon all member-counties of the Florida Association of Counties to unify and endorse the candidacy of Mayor Barbara Sharief for 2nd Vice President of the National Association of Counties; and

WHEREAS, Mayor Sharief has a passion to enhance the quality of care for the elderly and youth of Broward County; and

WHEREAS, Mayor Sharief was elected to serve as a City Commissioner for the City of Miramar, and later served as the City's Vice-Mayor; and

WHEREAS, in November 2010, Mayor Sharief was elected to the Broward County Board of County Commissioners, representing the citizens of District 8, as well as all the citizens of Broward County, and has been reelected subsequently; and

WHEREAS, in November 2014, her Commission colleagues selected her to serve as the Mayor of Broward County, and the theme for her term was "Broward Means Business," in which Mayor Sharief recognized and promoted several County, State, and Federal programs that help mentor and finance Broward County businesses; and

WHEREAS, Mayor Barbara Sharief has indicated her desire to run for 2nd Vice President of the National Association of Counties; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners supports and endorses the candidacy of Mayor Sharief for 2nd Vice President of the National Association of Counties; and

WHEREAS, Mayor Sharief has served as the President of the Florida Association of Counties and previously served as President-Elect, 1st Vice President, 2nd Vice President, and as a policy committee chair; and

WHEREAS, the National Association of Counties ("NACo") is the only national organization that represents county governments in the United States. Founded in 1935, NACO provides essential services to the nation's 3,069 counties. NACo advances issues with a unified voice before the federal government, improves the public's understanding of county government, assists counties in finding and sharing innovative solutions through education and research, and provides value-added services to save counties and taxpayers money; and

WHEREAS, Mayor Sharief is committed to increasing economic development opportunities, housing, creating jobs, increasing tourism, revitalizing neighborhoods, educating children, providing quality of life and care for senior citizens, and advocating for programs and funding to reduce homelessness, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That the Board supports and endorses the candidacy of Broward County Mayor Barbara Sharief as 2nd Vice President of the National Association of Counties.

Section 2. That the Board authorizes the County Administrator to provide support for the campaign using in-kind services, including but not limited to personnel, communications, the intergovernmental affairs, and other resources as deemed necessary to support the successful candidacy of Mayor Sharief for 2nd Vice President of the National Association of Counties.

Section 3. That the Board encourages all Florida county commissioners to attend the National Association of Counties Annual Exposition and Conference to be held July 13 - 16, 2018, in Davidson County, Nashville, Tennessee, so they can cast each County's ballot to elect Mayor Sharief as 2nd Vice President of the National Association of Counties.

Section 4. <u>SEVERABILITY</u>.

If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any Court to be invalid, the invalid portion shall be stricken, and such striking shall not affect the validity of the
