WHEREAS, as part of its consideration of the City as the location for its expanded headquarters, BEACHFRONT is requesting certification from the State of Florida as a "Qualified Target Industry Business" under the State of Florida Qualified Target Industry ("QTI") Tax Refund Program, pursuant to Section 288.106, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, BEACHFRONT is eligible to apply for the QTI Tax Refund pursuant

to Section 288.106, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the City hereby acknowledges that local financial support of 20

percent of any tax refund awarded by the State is required under the provisions of

Section 288.106, Florida Statutes, governing the State's QTI Tax Refund Program; and

WHEREAS, the City has committed to provide \$135,000, which is 50 percent of

the QTI local financial support BEACHFRONT must obtain under Section 288.106,

Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, Broward County will commit to provide \$135,000, which is the

additional 50 percent of the QTI local financial support; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager recommends approval of its share of the required

QTI local financial support for BEACHFRONT to locate its expanded headquarters

facility in the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that it is in the best interest of the citizens

and residents of the City of Miramar to approve the QTI local financial support in an

amount not-to-exceed \$135,000 for BEACHFRONT to locate its expanded headquarters

<u>Section 1</u>: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are confirmed and ratified as being true and correct and are made a specific part of this Resolution.
