

1 RESOLUTION NO. 2017-

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY  
3 COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA,  
4 PERTAINING TO THE RENAMING OF AN ESTABLISHED  
5 DIVISION OF THE PORT EVERGLADES DEPARTMENT;  
6 AMENDING SECTION 2.11 OF THE BROWARD COUNTY  
7 ADMINISTRATIVE CODE ("ADMINISTRATIVE CODE");  
8 AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN  
9 THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE  
10 DATE.

11 WHEREAS, the County Administrator seeks to rename the Port Everglades  
12 Department's Seaport Engineering and Construction Division to Seaport Engineering  
13 and Facilities Maintenance Division; and

14 WHEREAS, Broward County's Port Everglades Department is empowered to  
15 have charge and supervision of the planning, construction, management, operation,  
16 maintenance, improvement, repair, remediation, and alteration of buildings, facilities,  
17 harbors, and other County-owned Seaport facilities and property, NOW, THEREFORE,

18 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF  
19 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

20 Section 1. Section 2.11 of the Broward County Administrative Code is hereby  
21 amended to read as follows:

22 **2.11. Divisions and Offices; Established.**

23 The following divisions and offices are hereby established and placed under the  
24 supervision and control of the following departments:

...

e. *Port Everglades Department:*

- 1           1.     Business Administration Division;
- 2           2.     Finance Division;
- 3           3.     Operations Division;
- 4           4.     Business Development Division;
- 5           5.     Seaport Engineering and ~~Construction~~ Facilities Maintenance
- 6           Division.

8           Section 2.   SEVERABILITY.

9           If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any Court to be invalid, the  
10          invalid portion shall be stricken, and such striking shall not affect the validity of the  
11          remainder of this Resolution. If any Court determines that this Resolution, or any  
12          portion hereof, cannot be legally applied to any individual(s), group(s), entity(ies),  
13          property(ies), or circumstance(s), such determination shall not affect the applicability  
14          hereof to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

15          Section 3.   INCLUSION IN THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE.

16          It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of  
17          this Resolution shall become and be made a part of the Broward County Administrative  
18          Code; and that the sections of this Resolution be renumbered or relettered and the word  
19          "resolution" may be changed to "section," "article," or such other appropriate word or  
20          phrase in order to accomplish such intentions.
