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## **RESOLUTION NO. 2017-**

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY **BROWARD** COMMISSIONERS OF COUNTY. FLORIDA, **ACCEPTING** DONATION OF REFRIGERATED FOR USE FROM SEPTEMBER 8, SEMITRAILER VALUED THROUGH SEPTEMBER 15, 2017. HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500) OR MORE, FOR THE USE AND BENEFIT OF THE OFFICE OF THE MEDICAL EXAMINER AND SERVICES; **AUTHORIZING**  $\mathsf{THE}$ ADMINISTRATOR TO TAKE ALL ADMINISTRATIVE AND ACTIONS REQUIRED BUDGETARY TO IMPLEMENT ACCEPTANCE: AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Nationwide Haul generously agreed to temporarily donate a refrigerated semitrailer (for use beginning September 8, 2017, and ending September 15, 2017), valued at Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) or more, for the use and benefit of the Broward County Office of the Medical Examiner and Trauma Services ("Office of the Medical Examiner"); and

WHEREAS, Section 18.63 of the Broward County Administrative Code provides for the acceptance and acknowledgement by the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida ("Board"), of donations to the County that are valued at Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) or more; and

WHEREAS, due to time restrictions and the emergency nature of the need for additional refrigeration storage, the Office of the Medical Examiner was not able to provide advance notice of this donation; and

WHEREAS, the Board wishes to retroactively accept the generous gift and to express its gratitude for such donation, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Board hereby retroactively accepts a temporary donation of a refrigerated semitrailer from Nationwide Haul, Managing Director, Tracy Madon, 2221 NW 22nd Street, Pompano Beach, Florida 33069, for the use and benefit of the Broward County Office of the Medical Examiner and Trauma Services from September 8, 2017, through September 15, 2017, due to the potential increase of deaths following Hurricane Irma.

Section 2. The County Administrator is authorized to take all administrative and budgetary actions required to implement acceptance of the donation in this matter.

## Section 3. SEVERABILITY.

If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any Court to be invalid, the invalid portion shall be stricken, and such striking shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Resolution. If any Court determines that this Resolution, or any portion hereof, cannot be legally applied to any individual(s), group(s), entity(ies), property(ies), or circumstance(s), such determination shall not affect the applicability hereof to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

## Section 4. <u>EFFECTIVE DATE</u>.

This Resolution shall become effective retroactive to September 8, 2017.
