**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Impact Statement Re: Proposed Ordinance Repealing Section 21-3 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, Relating to the Unlawful Sale of Hypodermic Syringes or Needles; CAO files 17-026.08 & 17-420.00

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**Summary**

The proposed ordinance repeals in its entirety Section 21-3 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances pertaining to the unlawful sale of hypodermic syringes or needles unless authorized by prescription by a person authorized under Florida law. Section 21-3 was intended to help prevent drug use, however, the restriction could prevent some Broward County visitors from accessing needed medication and may increase the risk of disease transmission.

**Fiscal Impact**

The proposed ordinance is anticipated to have no material fiscal impact to Broward County.
