2 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY  
3 COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA,  
4 SUPPORTING THE GRANT APPLICATION TO THE  
5 BROWARD METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION  
6 ("MPO") SEEKING GRANT FUNDING UNDER THE MPO'S  
7 COMPLETE STREETS AND OTHER LOCALIZED  
8 INITIATIVES PROGRAM FOR RAISED MEDIANS AND  
9 PEDESTRIAN SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS ON NW 19<sup>th</sup>  
10 STREET FROM NW 31<sup>st</sup> AVENUE TO POWERLINE ROAD;  
11 AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN  
12 EFFECTIVE DATE.

13 WHEREAS, the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization ("MPO") has grant  
14 funds under its Complete Streets and Other Localized Initiatives Program ("Complete  
15 Streets") to construct raised medians and pedestrian facilities on roads off the state  
16 highway system; and

17 WHEREAS, Broward County ("County") intends to submit a grant application to  
18 the MPO seeking grant funds under the MPO's grant program in an amount up to Two  
19 Million Dollars (\$2,000,000) for raised landscaped medians, upgraded pedestrian scale  
20 lighting, milling and resurfacing, and a midblock crossing on NW 19<sup>th</sup> Street between  
21 NW 31<sup>st</sup> Avenue and Powerline Road (the "Project"); and

22 WHEREAS, NW 19<sup>th</sup> Street is a County road within the City of Fort Lauderdale;  
23 and

24 WHEREAS, the County is the owner of the road right-of-way for the Project and  
is committed to continue funding operation and maintenance of NW 19<sup>th</sup> Street; and

WHEREAS, the Project will further the County's Complete Streets efforts while  
furthering the County's goal to support the development, design, and construction of

1 sustainable, multimodal transportation facilities throughout the County, to meet the  
2 demands of residents, travelers, businesses, and the community; and

3 WHEREAS, the State of Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") will be  
4 the agency responsible for design and construction of the Project; and

5 WHEREAS, the Project shall be designed and constructed to meet the "Minimum  
6 Standards Applicable to Public Rights-of-Way Under Broward County Jurisdiction,"  
7 Chapter 25 of the Broward County Administrative Code; and

8 WHEREAS, the Project plans shall be submitted for review and approval to the  
9 Broward County Highway Construction and Engineering Division, NOW, THEREFORE,  
10

11 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF  
12 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

14 Section 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed  
15 as being true and correct, and are hereby made a part of this Resolution.  
16

17 Section 2. The Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida,  
18 ("Board") supports the County's application for grant funds through the MPO's Complete  
19 Streets and Other Localized Initiatives Program.

21 Section 3. The Board supports FDOT as the project designer and construction  
22 administrator.

1 Section 4. SEVERABILITY.

2 If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any Court to be invalid, the  
3 invalid portion shall be stricken, and such striking shall not affect the validity of the  
4 remainder of this Resolution. If any Court determines that this Resolution, or any  
5 portion hereof, cannot be legally applied to any individual(s), group(s), entity(ies),  
6 property(ies), or circumstance(s), such determination shall not affect the applicability  
7 hereof to any other individual group, entity, property, or circumstance.

9 Section 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.

10 This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
