This memorandum supersedes the memorandum dated August 5, 2015.

The Office of Economic and Small Business Development (OESBD) has conducted a review of CDM Smith, Inc.'s CBE Participation for RLI No. R1025211R1 Continuing Engineering Services for Water Treatment and Raw Water Production Systems (WTRPS) for Work Authorization (WA) 13-16. The overall CBE goal for the agreement is 25%. As a part of this contract, professional services are performed through the issuance of work authorizations. Compliance Comments

CDM Smith, Inc.'s CBE commitment for Work Authorization (WA) CDMS 13-16 has been revised from 5.3% to 2.82%. The reason for the commitment reduction is due to the allocation of the amended funds for Construction Management Services from a CBE subconsultant to the Engineer-of-Record who holds the permits and licenses required. In terms of the overall agreement, CDM Smith, Inc. committed to 25% and has attained 25.1% CBE participation to date. CDM Smith, Inc. is responsible to the project's current completion level approaching 62%, OESBD has requested and received an updated action plan from CDM Smith, Inc. for the duration of the contract. OESBD will continue to monitor CDM Smith, Inc.'s compliance with the established overall goal.
