NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held by the Broward County Board of County Commissioners (the "Commissioners"), at its regularly scheduled meeting on November 7, 2017 at 10:00 a.m., or as soon thereafter as the same may be heard, at 115 South Andrews Avenue, Room 422, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33301, for the purpose of receiving comments and hearing discussion concerning the issuance from time to time in one or more law-exempt and taxable series pursuant to a plan of financing by the Public Finance Authority (the "Authority") of its Charter School Revenue Bonds (Central Charter School Project) in an amount not to exceed \$13,500,000 (the "Bonds"), the proceeds of which shall be loaned by the Authority to Assistance Unlimited, Inc. dba Central Charter School, a Florida nonprofit corporation (the "Borrower") and applied by the Borrower to (a) acquire the real estate and improvements thereon currently used by the Borrower in the operation of Central Charter School (the "Facility"), which is located at 4525 N. State Road 7, Lauderdale Lakes, Florida within the territorial limits of Broward County, Florida; (b) acquire additional furniture, fixtures and equipment for the Facility; (c) refund the Authority's outstanding Charter School Revenue Bonds (Central Charter School Project) Series 2017A and Charter School Revenue Bonds (Central Charter School Project) Taxable Series 2017B, which were issued to finance the costs of renovations to and acquisition of furniture, fixtures and equipment for the Facility; (d) make a deposit to the debt service reserve fund; and (e) pay the costs of issuance of the Bonds and certain other costs incurred in connection with the issuance of the Bonds (the purposes described in clauses (a) through (e) are hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Project").

The Bonds are expected to be issued pursuant to Section 66.0304 of the Wisconsin Statutes, as amended, by the Authority, a unit of government, and a body corporate and politic organized under and pursuant to the provisions of Sections 66.0301, 66.0303 and 66.0304 of the Wisconsin Statutes, as amended. The Bonds will be special limited obligations of the Authority payable solely from the Trust Estate which includes loan repayments to be made by the Borrower to the Authority, and certain moneys and securities on deposit in the funds and accounts held by the Trustee under the terms of the Trust indenture for the Bonds. The Facility is currently operated by the Borrower, and is located at the address set forth above.

The Bonds will not be a debt or liability of Broward County, the State of Florida or any political subdivision thereof, and neither Broward County, the State of Florida, or any political subdivision thereof shall have any payment responsibility whatsoever in connection with the Bonds. The Bonds shall be special limited obligations of the Authority, payable solely from the Trust Estate.

A public hearing will be held pursuant to the requirements of Section 147.01 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"), at the above referenced time and place in connection with the proposed issuance of the Bonds to finance the costs of the Project described herein, at which time there will be an opportunity for persons to express their views on the foregoing. All interested taxpayers, property owners and citizens of Broward County are invited to attend this public hearing and, either personally or through their representatives, will be given an opportunity to express their views concerning the Project to be financed with the proceeds of the Bonds. Written comments may be submitted on or before 4:00 p.m. November 6, 2017, to Broward County, 115 South Andrews Avenue, Suite 513, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33301.
