RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF THE TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FEDERAL GRANT PROGRAM FUNDS PURSUANT TO 49 U.S.C. SECTION 5310, TO PURCHASE SEDANS FOR PARATRANSIT SERVICES, EACH VALUED AT TWENTY-TWO THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED FOUR DOLLARS (\$22,304); AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO ACCEPT THE GRANT FUNDING IF IT IS AWARDED; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Federal Transit Administration ("FTA") allocates funds to the State of Florida each year for the 49 U.S.C. Section 5310 Grant Program ("Program"); and

WHEREAS, the Program provides for the enhanced mobility of seniors and individuals with disabilities; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") has been designated by the Governor to administer the Program; and

WHEREAS, Broward County has the authority to apply for and accept grant awards made by FDOT and the FTA as authorized by Chapter 341, Florida Statutes, and the Federal Transit Administration Act of 1964, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the grant requires that the applicant provide a public hearing regarding the application for Section 5310 grant FDOT funding, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Director of the Transportation Department is authorized to sign the application to the Florida Department of Transportation for federal grant program funds pursuant to 49 U.S.C. Section 5310 to purchase sedans for paratransit services, each valued at Twenty-two Thousand Three Hundred Four Dollars (\$22,304).

Section 2. The County Administrator is authorized to accept a grant award, unless this Resolution is specifically rescinded, and to sign any and all documentation approved by the Office of the County Attorney that may be required in connection with the amended grant application and award.

Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
