1	(5) In addition to the two percent (2%) tax imposed under paragraph (1), the
2	one percent (1%) tax imposed under paragraph (2), the one percent (1%) tax imposed
3	under paragraph (3), and the one percent (1%) tax imposed under paragraph (4), the
4	Board hereby levies, imposes, and sets an additional one percent (1%) tax ("High
5	Tourism Impact Penny") pursuant to Section 125.0104(3)(m), Florida Statutes, on the
6	exercise of the privilege described therein. This additional one percent (1%) tax The
7	High Tourism Impact Penny shall be used for any of the authorized uses permitted by
8	Section 125.0104(5), Florida Statutes, and solely for the expansion, repair, or
9	remodeling of the Broward County Convention Center. Notwithstanding the foregoing
10	in the event that all of the proceeds from the High Tourism Impact Penny are not
11	needed for the expansion, repair, or remodeling of the Broward County Convention
12	Center, the remainder may be used, to the full extent permissible under applicable law,
13	for marketing and advertising to attract tourists. The imposition and levy of the High
14	Tourism Impact Penny shall be automatically repealed effective 11:59 p.m. on
15	March 31, 2021, unless the Broward County Administrator, prior to December 31, 2020,
16	has filed an affidavit in the Official Records of Broward County affirming that
17	construction activities to expand the Broward County Convention Center have
18	commenced. The High Tourism Impact Penny shall not be subject to, and is exempt
19	from, the requirements of Section 31½-17 of the Broward County Code.

Existing paragraphs (5) through (20) of Section 311/2-16 shall be Section 2. renumbered to reflect the addition of the new paragraph (5).
