2 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY
3 COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA,
4 APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE BROWARD COUNTY
5 TRANSIT 2017 TITLE VI PROGRAM; AND PROVIDING
6 FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

7 WHEREAS, as part of the landmark Civil Rights Act of 1964, the United States
8 Congress enacted Title VI, which prohibits discrimination on the basis of race, color,
9 and national origin in programs and activities receiving federal financial assistance; and

10 WHEREAS, 49 CFR Part 21 was enacted in order to effectuate the provisions of
11 Title VI in any program or activity receiving federal financial assistance from the U.S.
12 Department of Transportation (DOT); and

13 WHEREAS, Broward County is a designated recipient of Federal Transit
14 Administration (FTA) funds; and

15 WHEREAS, pursuant to 49 CFR Part 21.9(b), FTA requires Broward County to
16 document its compliance with DOT's Title VI regulations by submitting a Title VI
17 Program to FTA once every three years; and

18 WHEREAS, FTA issued Circular 4702.1B dated October 1, 2012, titled "Title VI
19 Requirements and Guidelines for Federal Transportation Administration Recipients,"
20 which enumerates the requirements for a Title VI Program, including new standards that
21 had not been required in prior Title VI Programs submitted by Broward County; and

22 WHEREAS, the Broward County Transit Division has developed the Broward
23 County Transit 2017 Title VI Program to be submitted to FTA; and

24 WHEREAS, the Title VI Program must be reviewed, approved, and adopted by
Broward County's governing entity prior to submission to FTA, NOW, THEREFORE,

1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
2 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

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4 Section 1. After review of the Broward County Transit 2017 Title VI Program,
5 the Broward County Board of County Commissioners hereby approves and adopts the
6 Broward County Transit 2017 Title VI Program, a copy of which is attached hereto and
7 incorporated herein by reference as if set forth in full.

8 Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.

9 This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
