2 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY
3 COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA,
4 ACCEPTING FROM FRIENDS OF THE SOUTH
5 REGIONAL/BROWARD COLLEGE LIBRARY, INC. A
6 DONATION OF TWO UXL POWER BAR CHARGING
7 TABLES, VALUED AT MORE THAN FIVE HUNDRED
8 DOLLARS (\$500), FOR THE USE AND BENEFIT OF THE
9 SOUTH REGIONAL/BROWARD COLLEGE LIBRARY,
10 AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO TAKE
11 ALL ADMINISTRATIVE AND BUDGETARY ACTIONS TO
12 IMPLEMENT ACCEPTANCE AND EXPENDITURE; AND
13 PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE
14 DATE.

15 WHEREAS, Friends of the South Regional-Broward College Library, Inc., has most
16 generously offered to donate to the County two UXL Power Bar charging tables, valued
17 at more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500), for the use and benefit of the South
18 Regional/Broward College Library; and

19 WHEREAS, Section 18.63 of the Broward County Administrative Code provides
20 for the acceptance and acknowledgement by the Board of County Commissioners of
21 Broward County, Florida ("Board"), of donations to the County that are valued at Five
22 Hundred Dollars (\$500) or more; and

23 WHEREAS, the Board wishes to accept the generous gift, and to express its
24 gratitude for such donation, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

1 Section 1. The Board hereby accepts the donation of two UXL Power Bar
2 charging tables, valued at more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500), from Friends of the
3 South Regional-Broward College Library, Inc., located at 7300 Pines Boulevard, Pembroke
4 Pines, Florida 33024.

5 Section 2. The County Administrator is hereby authorized to take all
6 administrative and budgetary actions and execute all forms required to implement
7 acceptance of the donation and expenditure of the funds in this matter.

8 Section 3. SEVERABILITY.

9 If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any Court to be invalid, the invalid
10 portion shall be stricken, and such striking shall not affect the validity of the remainder of
11 this Resolution. If any Court determines that this Resolution, or any portion hereof, cannot
12 be legally applied to any individual(s), group(s), entity(ies), property(ies), or
13 circumstance(s), such determination shall not affect the applicability hereof to any other
14 individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

15 Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

16 This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
