	Project Work Plan includes:
	Task 1: The Grantee and volunteer community liaisons will interview a minimum of 20 business and property owners to collect georeferenced and tabular data that describes the interdependence of various types of businesses. Information will include types of services provided, value of services, total assets, property value, growth, and flood risk planning. This information will be used to populate the model to be built in Task 2. Deliverable is a Geo-referenced database in excel format or equivalent. Due Date is 6/30/2018. Requests for payment must be made within 30 days of completion of the deliverable.
DELIVERABLES, MILESTONES OR SCOPE OF THIS ACTION	Task 2: The Grantee will hire a contractor to use the data collected in Task 1 to develop a "relationship model" that represents the flow of funds within the local economy. Once built, the model will be manipulated to test how flood conditions, shock, and other adaptation strategies will affect certain components of the business community and suggest implications for how property values, employment availability, and services available will respond. A summary report will be published that outlines the interdependencies and recommendations for increased economic resilience.
	Deliverable is a summary report of the stress test results of the relationship model in pdf format. Due Date is 6/30/2018. Requests for payment must be made within 30 days of completion of the deliverable. The Department will review the deliverable to ensure it meets the specifications provided in the Task Description, above.
