RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA. AUTHORIZING SUBMITTAL OF AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES GRANT APPLICATION IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED FORTY-ONE THOUSAND **EIGHTY-THREE** THE STATE **DOLLARS** (\$141,083),TO OF FLORIDA, OF HEALTH, FOR THE DEPARTMENT PURPOSE OF IMPROVING AND EXPANDING PREHOSPITAL EMERGENCY **SERVICES** MEDICAL ("EMS") IN BROWARD COUNTY AUTHORIZING ADMINISTRATOR EXECUTE THE APPLICATION PROVIDING CERTIFICATION RELATING TO THE USE OF EMS COUNTY GRANT FUNDS AND APPROVING BROWARD COUNTY'S EMS GRANT PROGRAM FUNDING DISTRIBUTION; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE AGREEMENTS AND AMENDMENTS TO AGREEMENTS; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO TAKE THE NECESSARY ADMINISTRATIVE AND **BUDGETARY ACTIONS** IMPLEMENTATION OF SAME; **PROVIDING** AND SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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WHEREAS, the Broward County Board of County Commissioners ("Board") desires to submit to the State of Florida, Department of Health ("DOH"), Bureau of Emergency Medical Services, Broward County's Fiscal Year 2018 Emergency Medical Services Grant Application ("Application") for grant funds in the amount of One Hundred Forty-One Thousand Eighty-Three Dollars (\$141,083); and

WHEREAS, the Board certifies that the grant funds will be used to improve and expand prehospital emergency medical services ("EMS") in Broward County, and will not be used to supplant existing County budget allocations for EMS; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to approve the proposed EMS County grant program funding distribution, subject to approval of the Application by the DOH, NOW, THEREFORE,

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BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Board authorizes the County Administrator to execute and submit the Application, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit 3-A, to the DOH for EMS County grant funds in the amount of One Hundred Forty-One Thousand Eighty-Three Dollars (\$141,083).

Section 2. The County certifies that the EMS County grant funds will improve and expand the County's prehospital emergency medical services and will not be used to supplant existing County budget allocations for EMS.

Section 3. The County approves the DOH EMS Grant Program's Request for Grant Fund Distribution attached hereto as Exhibit 3-B.

Section 4. Upon approval of the Application by the DOH, the County Administrator is authorized to execute agreements in a form approved by the Office of the County Attorney, which shall include the County's applicable standard form agreement provisions and incorporate insurance provisions approved by the County's Risk Management Division, for to the projects described in Exhibit 3-C, a copy of which is attached. The County Administrator is authorized to execute amendments to the agreements, in forms approved by the Office of the County Attorney, revising project leaders, extending the term, or increasing the funding amount for the partially funded grant described in Exhibit 3-C by utilizing unexpended EMS County Grant Funds allocated for FY 2018 projects.

Section 5. The County Administrator is authorized to take all necessary administrative and budgetary actions for implementation of same.
