2 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY  
3 COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA,  
4 ACCEPTING A DONATION OF FOUR (4) DOG WASTE  
5 STATIONS FROM THE FRIENDS OF TY PARK, INC.,  
6 VALUED AT FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500) OR MORE,  
7 FOR THE USE AND BENEFIT OF THE PARKS AND  
8 RECREATION DIVISION AT TOPEEKEEGEE YUGNEE (TY)  
9 PARK; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO  
10 TAKE ALL ADMINISTRATIVE AND BUDGETARY ACTIONS  
11 REQUIRED TO IMPLEMENT ACCEPTANCE; AND  
12 PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE  
13 DATE.

14 WHEREAS, Friends of TY Park, Inc., has most generously agreed to donate four  
15 (4) dog waste stations, valued at Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) or more, for the use and  
16 benefit of the Parks and Recreation Division at Topeekeegee Yugnee (TY) Park; and

17 WHEREAS, Section 18.63 of the Broward County Administrative Code provides  
18 for the acceptance and acknowledgement by the Board of County Commissioners of  
19 Broward County, Florida ("Board"), of donations to the County that are valued at  
20 Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) or more; and

21 WHEREAS, the Board wishes to accept the generous gift, and to express its  
22 gratitude for such donation, NOW, THEREFORE,

23 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF  
24 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Board hereby accepts a donation of four (4) dog waste stations  
as depicted in Exhibit "A," attached hereto, valued at Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) or  
more, from Friends of TY Park, Inc., whose local address is 4600 Sheridan Street,  
Suite #300, Hollywood, Florida 33021, for the use and benefit of the Parks and  
Recreation Division at TY Park.

1 Section 2. The County Administrator is authorized to take all administrative  
2 and budgetary actions required to implement acceptance of the donation in this matter.

3 Section 3. SEVERABILITY.

4 If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any Court to be invalid, the  
5 invalid portion shall be stricken, and such striking shall not affect the validity of the  
6 remainder of this Resolution. If any Court determines that this Resolution, or any portion  
7 hereof, cannot be legally applied to any individual(s), group(s), entity(ies), property(ies),  
8 or circumstance(s), such determination shall not affect the applicability hereof to any  
9 other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

10 Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

11 This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
