RESOLUTION NO. 2018-

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY. FLORIDA. DESIGNATING YOUTH THE BROWARD REENTRY COLLABORATIVE COUNCIL AS PLANNING THE COUNCIL FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF CHILDREN AND FAMILIES CRIMINAL JUSTICE, MENTAL HEALTH AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE REINVESTMENT GRANT; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida ("Board"), recognizes that the Broward Behavioral Health Coalition, the managing entity for substance abuse and mental health services in Broward County, is seeking authorization to apply for the State of Florida Department of Children and Families Criminal Justice, Mental Health and Substance Abuse Reinvestment Grant ("Grant"); and

WHEREAS, the Grant provides funding to implement the recommendations of the Broward Youth Reentry Collaborative Council regarding (i) increasing efforts to transform the juvenile and criminal justice systems, (ii) increasing public safety, (iii) averting increased spending, (iv) decreasing residential placements, (v) improving treatment services for participants 12 to 21 years of age, and (vi) improving accessibility and effectiveness of treatment services for those who have a mental illness, substance abuse disorders, or co-occurring mental health and substance abuse disorders; and

WHEREAS, Section 394.656, Florida Statutes, provides that a county, or a not-for-profit community provider or managing entity designated by the county planning council or committee, as described in the above-referenced statute, may apply for the Grant; and

WHEREAS, Section 394.657, Florida Statutes, mandates that the Board designate a county public safety coordinating council, or another criminal or juvenile justice mental health and substance abuse council or committee, as the planning council or committee to implement the Grant; and

WHEREAS, the membership of the Broward Youth Reentry Collaborative Council complies with the requirements of Section 394.657, Florida Statutes, and the Board therefore desires to designate the Broward Youth Reentry Collaborative Council as the planning council for implementation of the Grant, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein as if set forth in full hereunder.

Section 2. Pursuant to Section 394.657, Florida Statutes, the Board hereby designates the Broward Youth Reentry Collaborative Council as the planning council for implementation of the State of Florida Department of Children and Families Criminal Justice, Mental Health and Substance Abuse Reinvestment Grant.

Section 3. Pursuant to Section 394.657, Florida Statutes, the Board hereby requires the Broward Youth Reentry Collaborative Council to make formal recommendations to the Board regarding how the Grant may best be implemented within Broward County.

1 Section 4. SEVERABILITY. 2 If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any Court to be invalid, the 3 invalid portion shall be stricken, and such striking shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Resolution. If any Court determines that this Resolution, or any 4 5 portion hereof, cannot be legally applied to any individual(s), group(s), entity(ies), 6 property(ies), or circumstance(s), such determination shall not affect the applicability 7 hereof to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance. 8 Section 7.
