

1 RESOLUTION NO. 2018-

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY
3 COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA,
4 DESIGNATING THE BROWARD YOUTH REENTRY
5 COLLABORATIVE COUNCIL AS THE PLANNING
6 COUNCIL FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF THE STATE OF
7 FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF CHILDREN AND FAMILIES
8 CRIMINAL JUSTICE, MENTAL HEALTH AND SUBSTANCE
9 ABUSE REINVESTMENT GRANT; AND PROVIDING FOR
10 SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

11 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida
12 ("Board"), recognizes that the Broward Behavioral Health Coalition, the managing entity
13 for substance abuse and mental health services in Broward County, is seeking
14 authorization to apply for the State of Florida Department of Children and Families
15 Criminal Justice, Mental Health and Substance Abuse Reinvestment Grant ("Grant");
16 and

17 WHEREAS, the Grant provides funding to implement the recommendations of
18 the Broward Youth Reentry Collaborative Council regarding (i) increasing efforts to
19 transform the juvenile and criminal justice systems, (ii) increasing public safety, (iii)
20 averting increased spending, (iv) decreasing residential placements, (v) improving
21 treatment services for participants 12 to 21 years of age, and (vi) improving accessibility
22 and effectiveness of treatment services for those who have a mental illness, substance
23 abuse disorders, or co-occurring mental health and substance abuse disorders; and

24 WHEREAS, Section 394.656, Florida Statutes, provides that a county, or a
not-for-profit community provider or managing entity designated by the county planning
council or committee, as described in the above-referenced statute, may apply for the
Grant; and

1 WHEREAS, Section 394.657, Florida Statutes, mandates that the Board
2 designate a county public safety coordinating council, or another criminal or juvenile
3 justice mental health and substance abuse council or committee, as the planning
4 council or committee to implement the Grant; and

5 WHEREAS, the membership of the Broward Youth Reentry Collaborative Council
6 complies with the requirements of Section 394.657, Florida Statutes, and the Board
7 therefore desires to designate the Broward Youth Reentry Collaborative Council as the
8 planning council for implementation of the Grant, NOW, THEREFORE,

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10 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
11 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

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13 Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein
14 as if set forth in full hereunder.

15 Section 2. Pursuant to Section 394.657, Florida Statutes, the Board hereby
16 designates the Broward Youth Reentry Collaborative Council as the planning council for
17 implementation of the State of Florida Department of Children and Families Criminal
18 Justice, Mental Health and Substance Abuse Reinvestment Grant.

19 Section 3. Pursuant to Section 394.657, Florida Statutes, the Board hereby
20 requires the Broward Youth Reentry Collaborative Council to make formal
21 recommendations to the Board regarding how the Grant may best be implemented
22 within Broward County.

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1 Section 4. SEVERABILITY.

2 If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any Court to be invalid, the
3 invalid portion shall be stricken, and such striking shall not affect the validity of the
4 remainder of this Resolution. If any Court determines that this Resolution, or any
5 portion hereof, cannot be legally applied to any individual(s), group(s), entity(ies),
6 property(ies), or circumstance(s), such determination shall not affect the applicability
7 hereof to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

8 Section 7. EFFECTIVE DATE.

9 This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
