2 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY  
3 COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA,  
4 ACCEPTING AN IN-KIND DONATION OF AN AROUND-  
5 THE-PUMP FOAM PROPORTIONER AND FOAM WAND  
6 FROM BUCKEYE TERMINALS, LLC, TO BE USED FOR  
7 COMBATING SMALL PETROLEUM FIRES AND  
8 ASSISTING IN EXTINGUISHING LARGER TANK FIRES AT  
9 PORT EVERGLADES; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY  
10 ADMINISTRATOR TO TAKE ALL NECESSARY  
11 ADMINISTRATIVE ACTIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR  
12 SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

13 WHEREAS, Buckeye Terminals, LLC, would like to donate an Around-The-Pump  
14 Foam Proportioner (WATP) and Foam Wand to Port Everglades Department of Broward  
15 County for use in combating small petroleum fires involving the seal of a petroleum  
16 storage tank and assisting in extinguishing larger tank fires; and

17 WHEREAS, Section 18.63 of the Broward County Administrative Code provides  
18 for the acceptance and acknowledgement by the Board of County Commissioners of  
19 Broward County, Florida ("Board"), of donations to the County that are valued at Five  
20 Hundred Dollars (\$500) or more; and

21 WHEREAS, the Board desires to accept the WATP and Foam Wand to assist the  
22 Port Everglades Department with extinguishing petroleum tank fires throughout Port  
23 Everglades, NOW, THEREFORE,

24 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF  
BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

1 Section 1. That the Board hereby accepts the donation of the WATP and  
2 Foam Wand, valued at Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) or more, from Buckeye Terminals,  
3 LLC, for use in fighting petroleum tank fires at Port Everglades.

4 Section 2. The County Administrator or designee is hereby authorized to take  
5 all necessary administrative actions to implement the acceptance of the WATP and  
6 Foam Wand described herein.

7 Section 3. SEVERABILITY.

8 If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any Court to be invalid, the  
9 invalid portion shall be stricken, and such striking shall not affect the validity of the  
10 remainder of this Resolution. If any Court determines that this Resolution, or any  
11 portion hereof, cannot be legally applied to any individual(s), group(s), entity(ies),  
12 property(ies), or circumstance(s), such determination shall not affect the applicability  
13 hereof to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

14 Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

15 This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
