2 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY
3 COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA,
4 SUPPORTING THE METROPOLITAN PLANNING
5 ORGANIZATION'S MOBILITY PROJECTS TO ENHANCE
6 BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN SAFETY ALONG
7 DESIGNATED ROADWAYS WITHIN BROWARD COUNTY;
8 RECOGNIZING FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF
9 TRANSPORTATION AS THE PROJECTS' DESIGNER AND
10 CONSTRUCTION ADMINISTRATOR; AND PROVIDING
11 FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

12 WHEREAS, the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization ("MPO") has funds
13 under its Transportation Improvement Program to construct bicycle lanes and
14 pedestrian sidewalks along several roadways in Broward County ("County") within the
15 cities of Coconut Creek, Coral Springs, Dania Beach, Deerfield Beach, Fort Lauderdale,
16 Hollywood, Oakland Park, Pompano Beach, and Tamarac (collectively, "Cities"); and

17 WHEREAS, the following projects (collectively, "Projects") will enhance the
18 following roadways:

- 19 • NW 21st Avenue from Oakland Park Boulevard to Commercial Boulevard
20 (FM 4366851);
- 21 • Coral Ridge Drive from Royal Palm Boulevard to Holmberg Road (FM 4377961);
- 22 • Coral Ridge Drive from Southgate Boulevard to Royal Palm Boulevard
23 (FM 4377981);
- 24 • Copans Road from NW 36th Avenue to Blount Road (FM 4362261);
- NW 49th Street/NE 48th Street from Powerline Road to US 1 (FM 4346861);
- SW 40 Avenue from Stirling Road to Griffin Road (FM 4361961); and

- 1 • Lyons Road from the C-14 Canal to the Sawgrass Expressway (FM 4363191);

3 WHEREAS, the MPO collaborated with the Broward County Highway
4 Construction and Engineering Division, the Cities, and the Florida Department of
5 Transportation ("FDOT") to develop the Projects; and

6 WHEREAS, the Projects will further the County's complete streets efforts while
7 furthering the County's goal to support the development, design, and construction of
8 sustainable, multi modal transportation facilities throughout the County, to meet the
9 demands of residents, travelers, and businesses; and

10 WHEREAS, the County and the Cities may own rights-of-way within the limits of
11 the Projects; and

12 WHEREAS, the County is committed to continue funding operation and
13 maintenance of these enhancements within its rights-of-way, in accordance with its
14 Traffic Engineering Agreements with the Cities; and

15 WHEREAS, FDOT will be the agency responsible for the design and construction
16 administration of the Projects; and

17 WHEREAS, FDOT will design and construct the Projects to meet or exceed the
18 Minimum Standards Applicable to Public Rights-Of-Way under Broward County
19 Jurisdiction, Chapter 25 of the Broward County Administrative Code, NOW,
