WHEREAS, the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization ("MPO") has funds under its Transportation Improvement Program to construct bicycle lanes and pedestrian sidewalks along several roadways in Broward County ("County") within the cities of Coconut Creek, Coral Springs, Dania Beach, Deerfield Beach, Fort Lauderdale, Hollywood, Oakland Park, Pompano Beach, and Tamarac (collectively, "Cities"); and

WHEREAS, the following projects (collectively, "Projects") will enhance the following roadways:

- NW 21st Avenue from Oakland Park Boulevard to Commercial Boulevard (FM 4366851);
- Coral Ridge Drive from Royal Palm Boulevard to Holmberg Road (FM 4377961);
- Coral Ridge Drive from Southgate Boulevard to Royal Palm Boulevard (FM 4377981);
- Copans Road from NW 36th Avenue to Blount Road (FM 4362261);
- NW 49th Street/NE 48th Street from Powerline Road to US 1 (FM 4346861);
- SW 40 Avenue from Stirling Road to Griffin Road (FM 4361961); and

Lyons Road from the C-14 Canal to the Sawgrass Expressway (FM 4363191);
 and

WHEREAS, the MPO collaborated with the Broward County Highway Construction and Engineering Division, the Cities, and the Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") to develop the Projects; and

WHEREAS, the Projects will further the County's complete streets efforts while furthering the County's goal to support the development, design, and construction of sustainable, multi modal transportation facilities throughout the County, to meet the demands of residents, travelers, and businesses; and

WHEREAS, the County and the Cities may own rights-of-way within the limits of the Projects; and

WHEREAS, the County is committed to continue funding operation and maintenance of these enhancements within its rights-of-way, in accordance with its Traffic Engineering Agreements with the Cities; and

WHEREAS, FDOT will be the agency responsible for the design and construction administration of the Projects; and

WHEREAS, FDOT will design and construct the Projects to meet or exceed the Minimum Standards Applicable to Public Rights-Of-Way under Broward County Jurisdiction, Chapter 25 of the Broward County Administrative Code, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

1	Section 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed
2	as being true and correct and are made part of this Resolution.
3	Section 2. The Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida
4	("Board"), supports the Projects which will improve conditions for bicyclists and
5	pedestrians along the identified roadways.
6	Section 3. The Board supports FDOT as the Projects' designer and
7	construction administrator.
8	Section 4. <u>SEVERABILITY</u> .
9	If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any Court to be invalid, the
10	invalid portion shall be stricken, and such striking shall not affect the validity of the
11	remainder of this Resolution. If any Court determines that this Resolution, or any
12	portion hereof, cannot be legally applied to any individual(s), group(s), entity(ies),
13	property(ies), or circumstance(s), such determination shall not affect the applicability
14	hereof to any other individual, group, entity, property or circumstance.
15	Section 5. <u>EFFECTIVE DATE</u> .
16	This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
