b. No trust monies shall be disbursed from the Broward County Alcohol and Drug Substance Abuse Advisory Board Trust Fund unless such expenditures have been authorized by a majority of the Trust Fund Committee and approved by the Board of County Commissioners.

d. Upon a zero balance in the Trust Fund, the Substance Abuse Advisory

Board Trust Fund Committee shall be automatically sunsetted.

Section 5. Sections 12.225 and 12.227 of the Broward County Administrative Code regarding the Small Business Development Advisory Board are hereby amended to read as follows:

12.225. Appointment and Composition.

a. The Advisory Board shall be composed of eleven (11) <u>voting</u> members appointed by the Board of County Commissioners, all of whom shall be residents of Broward County. Each Broward County Commissioner shall nominate one (1) member to the Advisory Board. Two (2) of the eleven (11) members, who may be nominated by any County Commissioner, shall be at large positions, <u>serving four-year terms</u>, without regard to <u>best efforts</u> the categorical requirements below, to allow <u>for</u> greater citizen participation. For the remaining nine (9) members, <u>best efforts should be made to the Board shall</u> appoint members who represent the following <u>categories</u>:

- b. Members of the Advisory Board shall receive no compensation for their service. However, at the discretion of, and within annual appropriations made by the Board of County Commissioners, and with the prior approval of the Director of the Office of Economic and Small Business Development, Advisory Board members may be reimbursed for any actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their Advisory Board duties upon the prior approval of the Director of the Office of Economic and Small Business Development, subject to the annual appropriations made by the Board of County Commissioners, the limitations of Chapter 112, Florida Statutes, and County policy.
- c. Except as otherwise provided herein, the members of the Advisory Board shall serve subject to the provisions of Section 1-233, Broward County Code of Ordinances, as may be amended from time to time.
- d. The members of the Advisory Board shall represent the interests and needs of persons in Broward County who are involved in small business development. For purposes of this Part XXIII, the term "small business" shall mean as be defined in accordance with Subsection 288.703(1)(6), Florida Statutes, as may be amended from time to time.

12.227. Officers: Rules of procedure.

a. The members of the Advisory Board shall annually elect a Chair and Vice Chair, and may elect such other officers as the members of the Advisory Board may determine to be necessary in carrying out the responsibilities of the Advisory Board. No Advisory Board member shall be elected to serve in the same Advisory Board office for more than two (2) consecutive terms.

regarding the Central County Community Advisory Board is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 12.241 of the Broward County Administrative Code

12.241. Membership.

Section 6.

- b. All members of the Board shall reside in the applicable community. A member serving on the Board in the capacity as president of the recognized neighborhood association shall serve for the duration of their his or her term as president, unless removed from the Board by the Commission. In the event a neighborhood association president is unable or unwilling to serve on the Board, or is removed from the Board by the Commission, the vice-president of the neighborhood association shall serve on the Board. If neither is willing or able to serve on the Board, or both are removed from the Board by the Commission, the Commission shall appoint a resident from the applicable community from the list of neighborhood residents wishing to serve on the Board. Board members shall serve subject to the provisions of Section 1-233 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances.
- c. Any member of the Board may be removed from the Board without cause by a majority vote of the Commission. The Board may recommend to the Commission removal of a member of the Board. The Board must give the board member reasonable notice and an opportunity to be heard before making its recommendation. The Commission may consider removal of a member of the Board upon its own initiative.
- e. d. No member of the Board shall receive compensation for performance of Board duties.

Section 7. Section 12.265 of the Broward County Administrative Code regarding the Public Safety Coordinating Council Advisory Board is hereby amended to read as follows:

12.265. Term of Appointees.

b. The Board of County Commissioners or the appointing authority may remove any of its appointments for fixed terms for misconduct, incompetencye, or neglect of duty on its own motion or upon the recommendation of the Council. Except where otherwise inconsistent herein, members of the Council shall serve according to the provisions of Section 1-233 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, as may be amended from time to time. Members of the Council who are appointed based on their specific position shall not be subject to the automatic removal provisions set forth in Section 1-233, Broward County Code. Members of the Council are not subject to Section 1-233, Broward County Code of Ordinances.

Section 8. Section 12.290 of the Broward County Administrative Code regarding the Broward County Animal Care Advisory Committee is hereby amended to read as follows:

12.290. Membership.

The Advisory Committee shall be composed of eighteen (18) voting members, all of whom shall be residents of Broward County. Each Broward County Commissioner shall appoint nominate two (2) members to the Advisory Committee, one of whom shall reside within the appointing commissioner's district using the categorical

- 7. A member of a wildlife animal rescue organization full-time employee or active board member from a wildlife or large animal rescue organization who has at least one (1) year of experience actively managing operations in the organization;
- 8. An owner or full-time employee of the pet retail industry, partner, or officer of a pet retail store who resides in Broward County, and whose business represents the local sales market; and
- 9. A member from the State of Florida Broward County Health Department full-time employee (supervisor, manager, director, etc.) from the State of Florida

 Broward County Health Department, or someone who specializes in epidemiology, zoonotic, or communicable diseases.

Section 9. <u>SEVERABILITY</u>.

If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any Court to be invalid, the invalid portion shall be stricken, and such striking shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Resolution. If any Court determines that this Resolution, or any portion hereof, cannot be legally applied to any individual(s), group(s), entity(ies), property(ies), or circumstance(s), such determination shall not affect the applicability hereof to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

Section 10. INCLUSION IN THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE.

It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of this Resolution shall become and be made a part of the Broward County Administrative Code; and that the sections of this Resolution be renumbered or relettered and the word
