SUBJECT: Fiscal Impact Statement Re: Proposed Ordinance Amending Section 1-310 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, Relating to Medical Marijuana Advisory Board Requirements for Consumer Advocate Membership

Summary

The proposal amends Section 1-310 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances which outlines the membership of the Medical Marijuana Advisory Board. The amendments to this section of the ordinance outline who shall be eligible for membership as part of the board. The ordinance proposes that a qualified patient advocate defined as a qualified patient, caregiver, or close relative of a qualified patient. Members of the Medical Marijuana Board will continue to be appointed by the Broward County Board of County Commissioners.

Fiscal Impact

The proposed ordinance is anticipated to have no significant fiscal impact on Broward County operations.
